APRIL 2010

REVIEW OF OVERSEAS TRADE

During the month of April 2010 imports to Barbados were valued at \$178.9 million, whilst total exports from Barbados were valued at \$55.8 million. This resulted in a visible trade deficit of 123.2 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of 121.2 million for April 2009.

Imports for April 2010 were \$2.2 million less than imports for April 2009, a decrease of 1.2%. Total exports decreased in value by some \$4.0 million or 7.0% of the April 2009 figure. Domestic exports increased by \$2.5 million or 5.6% over April 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$1.6 million or 11.3% over the corresponding month 2009.

For the period January - April 2010, the value of imports to Barbados was \$723.7 million, whilst the value of total exports was \$198.9 million representing an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$524.7 million as compared to a similar deficit of 559.2 million for January - April 2009.

Imports for January - April 2010 were \$50.1 million less than imports for the same period 2009, an increase of 6.5%. Total exports showed a decrease of some \$15.6 million or 7.3% over the January - April 2009 figure. Domestic exports increased by \$0.4 million or 0.3% over January - April 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$15.2 million or 20.1% over the corresponding period 2009.

CARICOM TRADE

During the month of April 2010 imports from Caricom countries were valued at \$18.9 million whilst total exports to Caricom were valued at \$21.5 million resulting in a trade deficit of \$1.1 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$3.5 million for April 2009.

Caricom imports for April 2010 were \$0.9 million less than Caricom imports for April 2008, a decrease of 5.2%. Total exports to Caricom for April 2010 were \$1.5 million more than total exports for April 2009, an increase of 6.9%. Domestic exports increased by \$0.8 million or 4.9% over the corresponding month 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$0.6 million or 14.9% of the April 2009 figure.

For the period January - April 2010 total imports from Caricom were valued at \$77.4 million whilst total exports were \$83.7 million resulting in an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$6.3 million as compared with a deficit of \$5.2 million for the same period of 2009.

During this period Caricom imports were approximately \$7.8 million less than those over the same period in 2009 a decrease of 9.2%. Total exports to Caricom for January - April 2010 were \$6.7 million more than total exports for the corresponding period 2009, an increase of 7.4%. Domestic exports increased by \$0.2 million or 0.3% over the same period 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$6.9 million or 28.0% over the January - April 2009 figure.

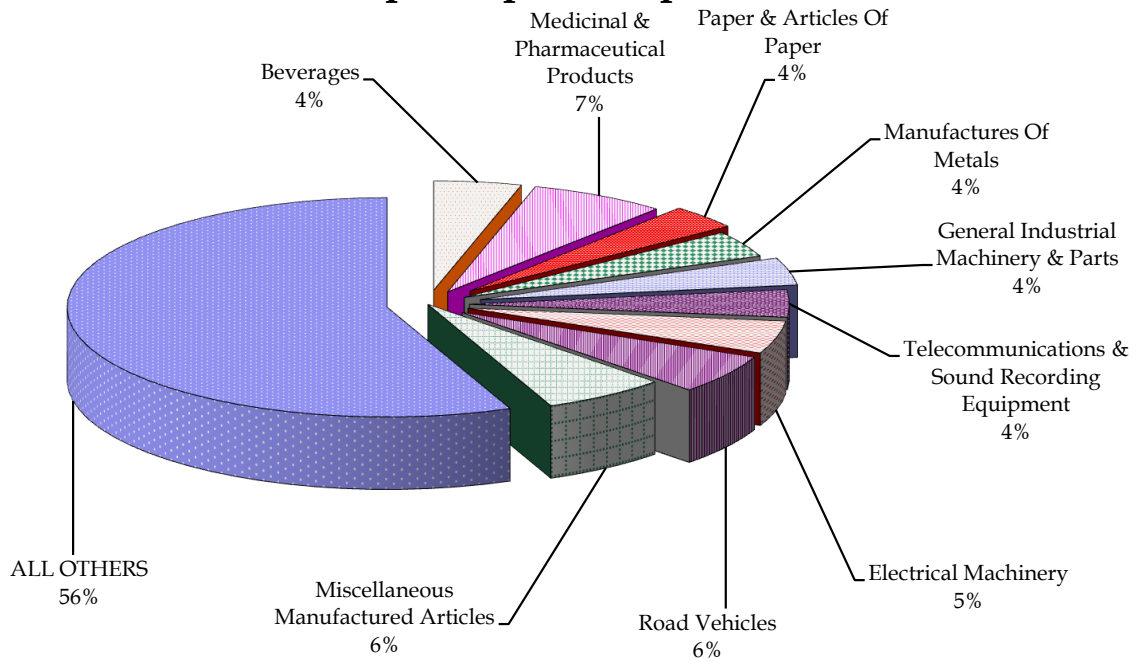

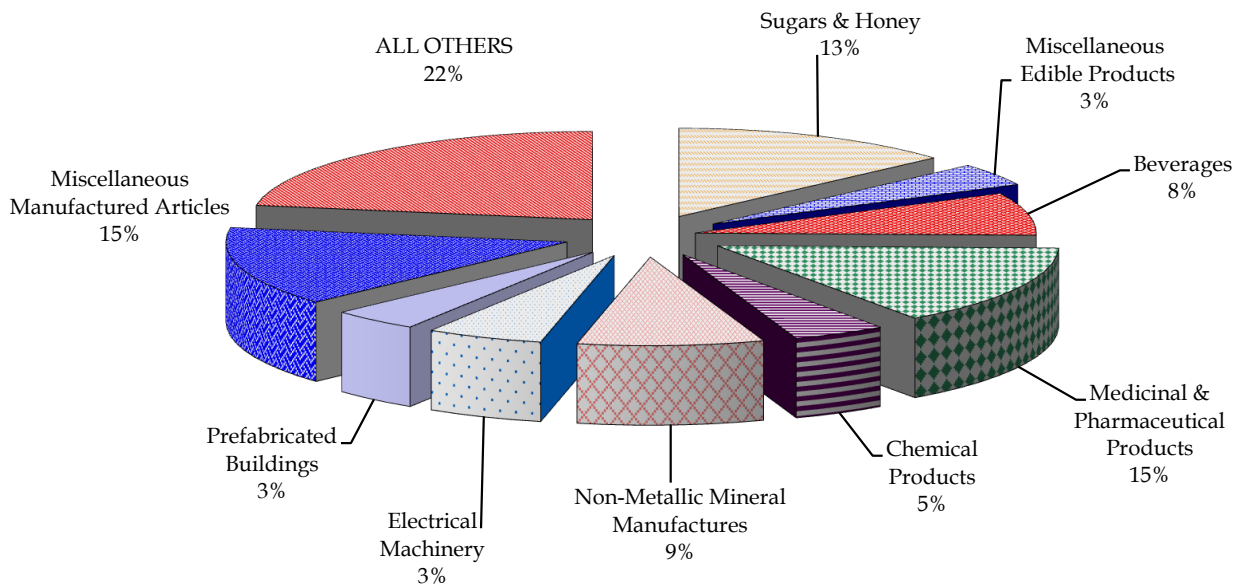

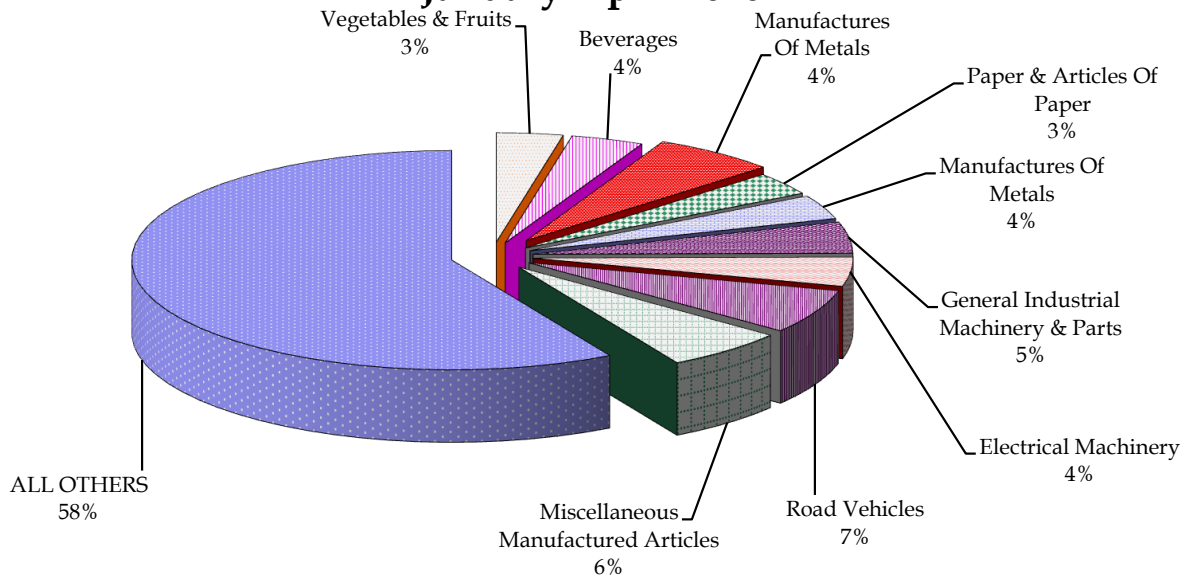

Principal Domestic Exports January- April 2010

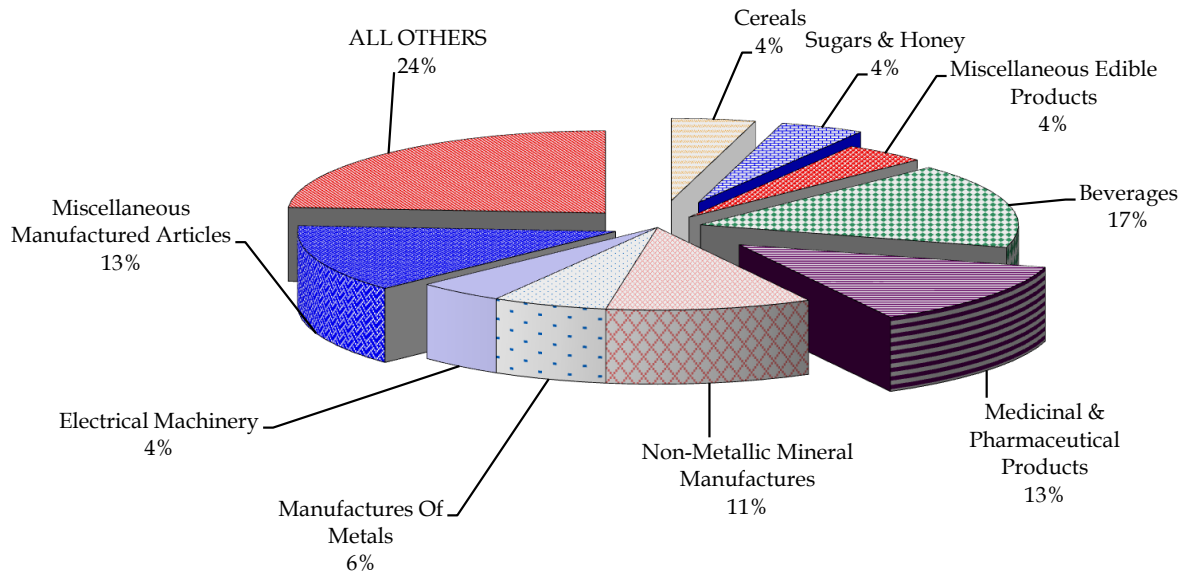

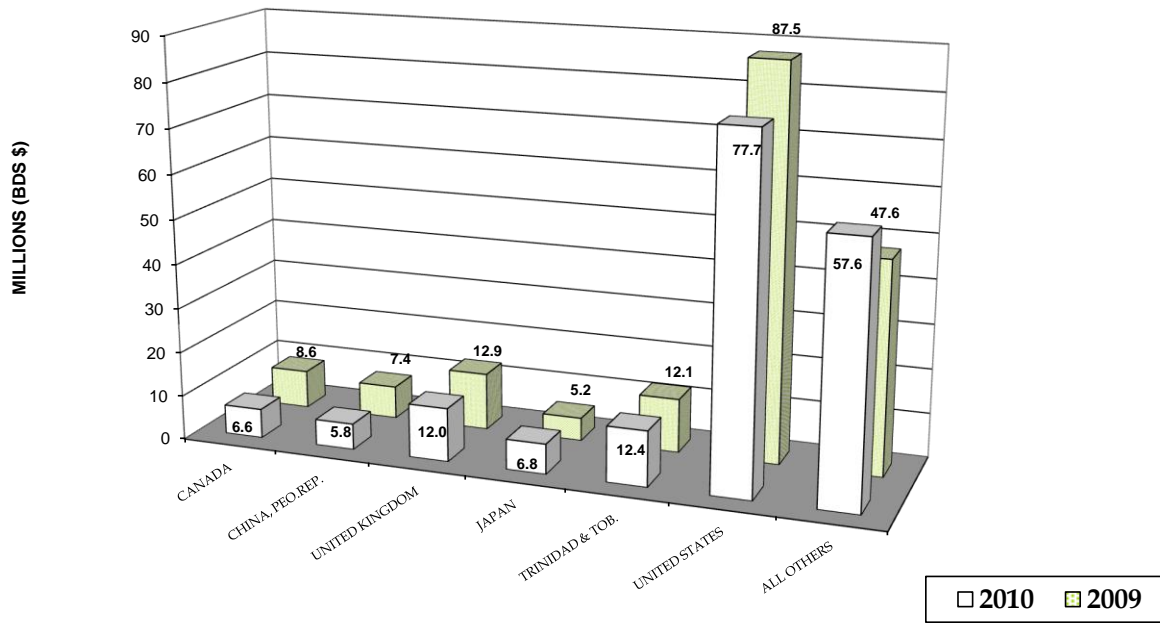

APRIL 2010 WITH THE CORRESPONDING MONTH OF 2009

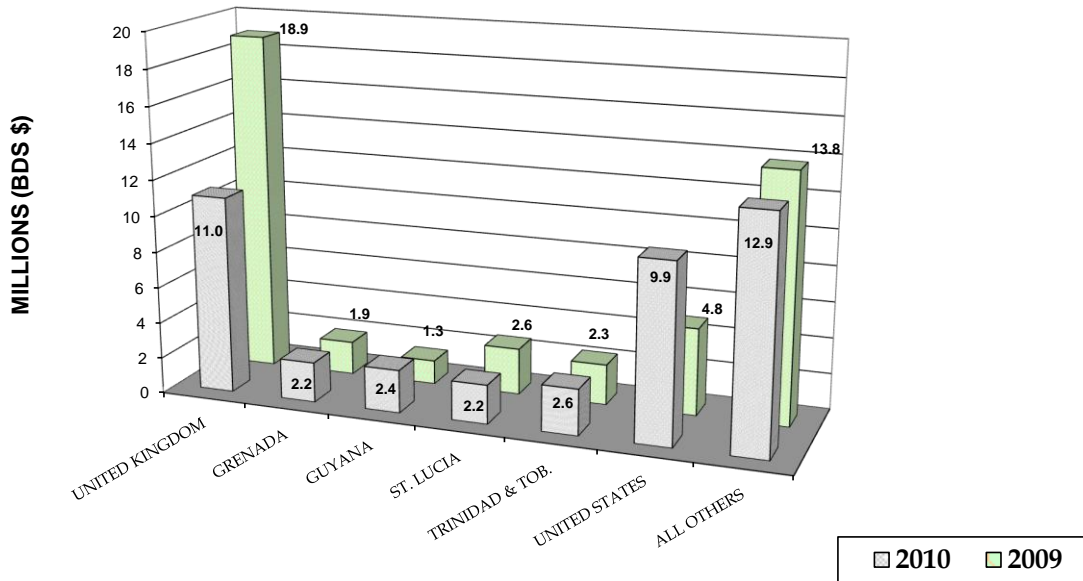

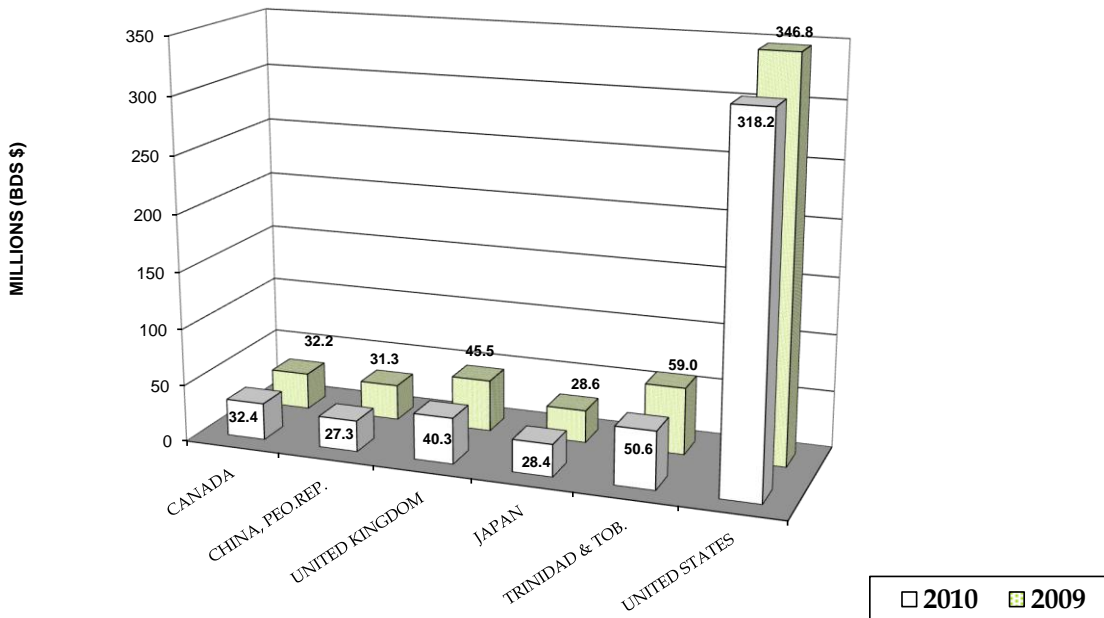

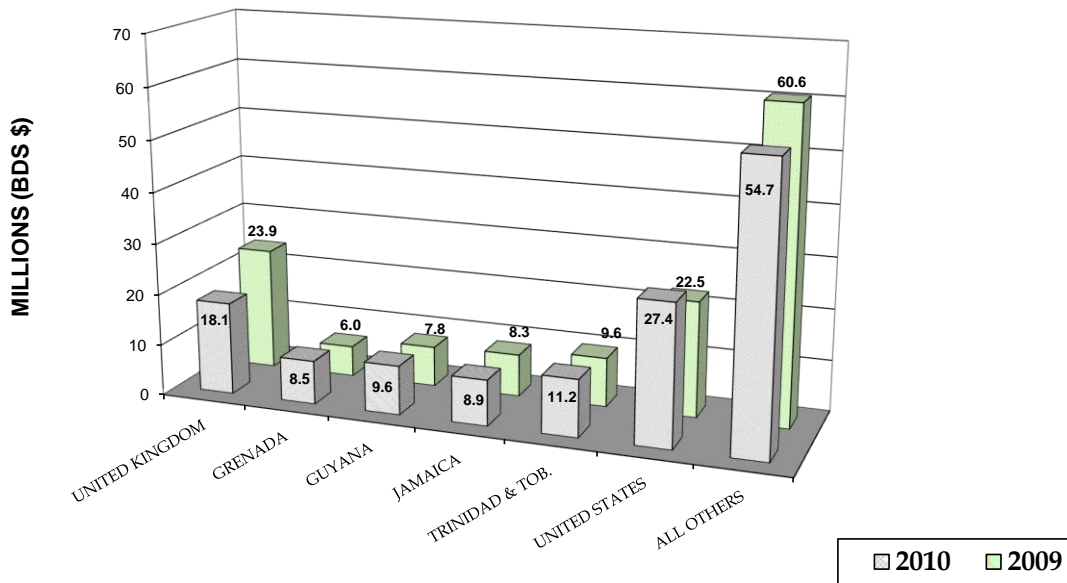

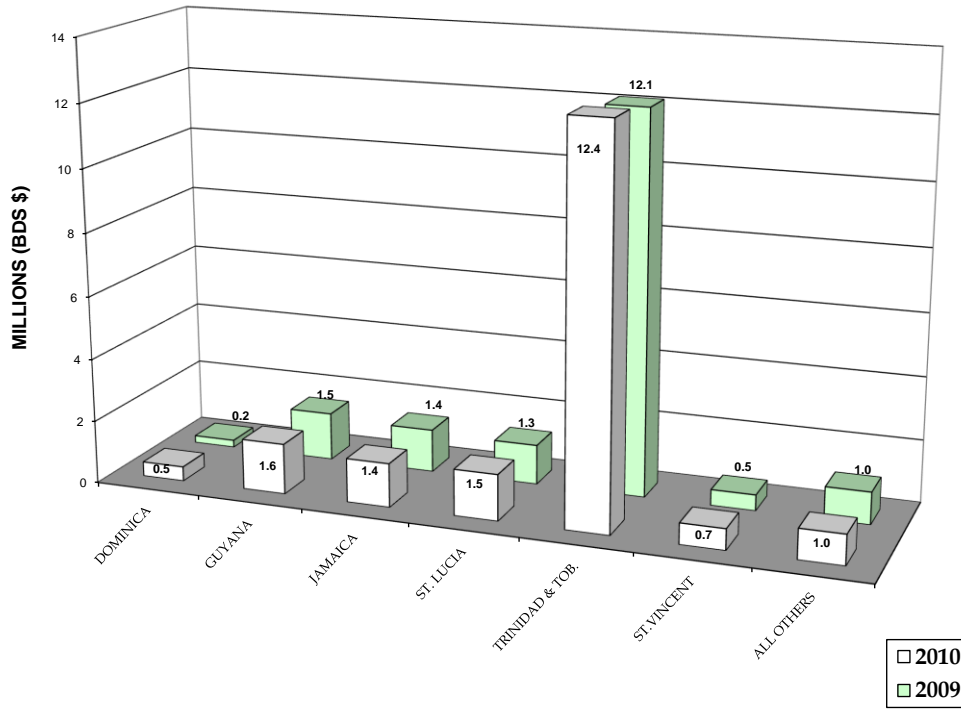

APRIL 2010 WITH THE CORRESPONDING MONTH OF 2009

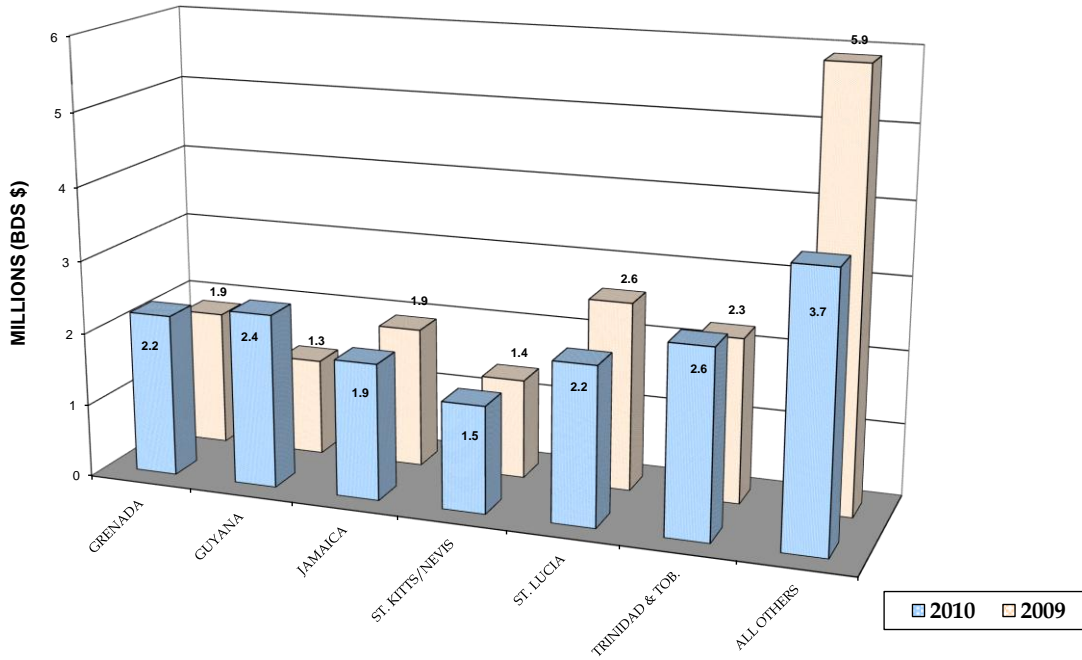

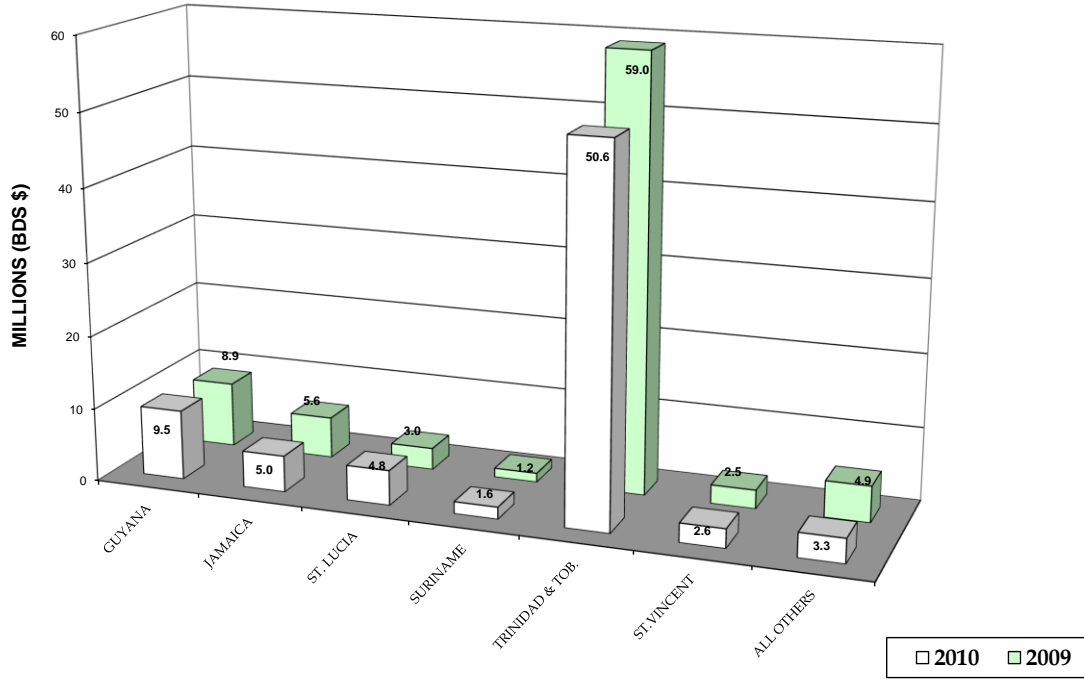

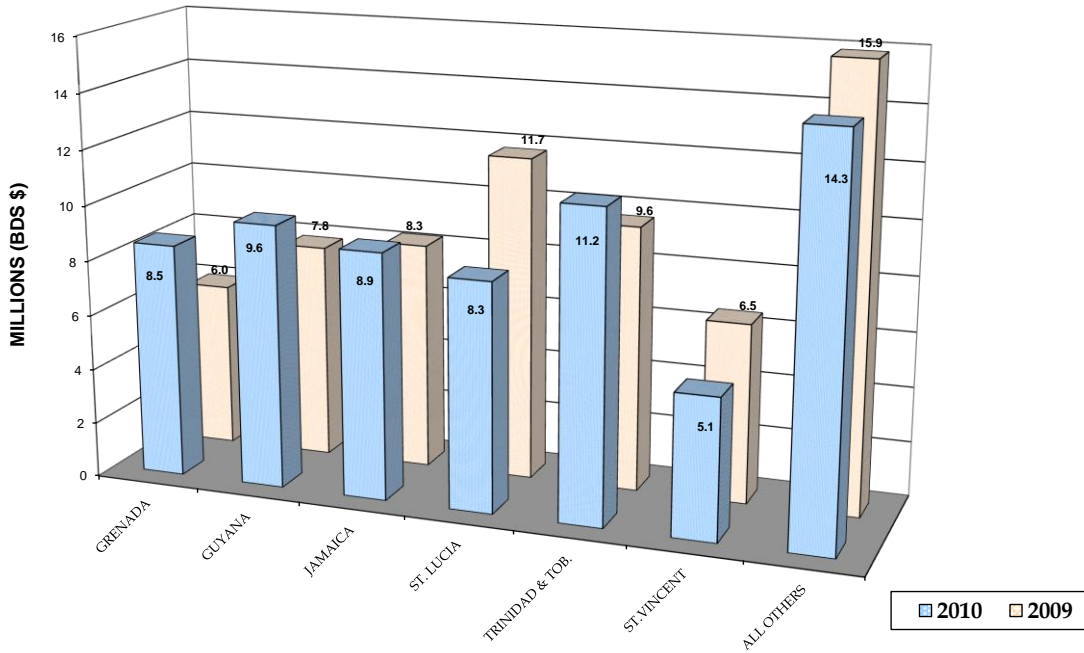
