

**COMPARISON OF TOURIST ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE**  
**September 2008 AND 2009**

Stay-over visitor arrivals for September 2009 numbered 28,892 representing a decrease of 5,274 or 15.4 % when compared to September 2008. There were increases in the Germany and Trinidad and Tobago markets of 4 or 1.2% and 51 or 2.9 % respectively. Decreases of 2,331 or 26.5 %, 139 or 7.5 %, 1,808 or 13.8 %, 238 or 19.2 %, 614

or 11.5 % and 199 or 11.9 % were seen in the U.S.A, Canada, U.K, Other Europe, Other Caricom and Other Countries markets respectively. Cruise Passenger arrivals for September 2009 were 27,268 representing an increase of 14,718 or 117.3 % when compared to September 2008.

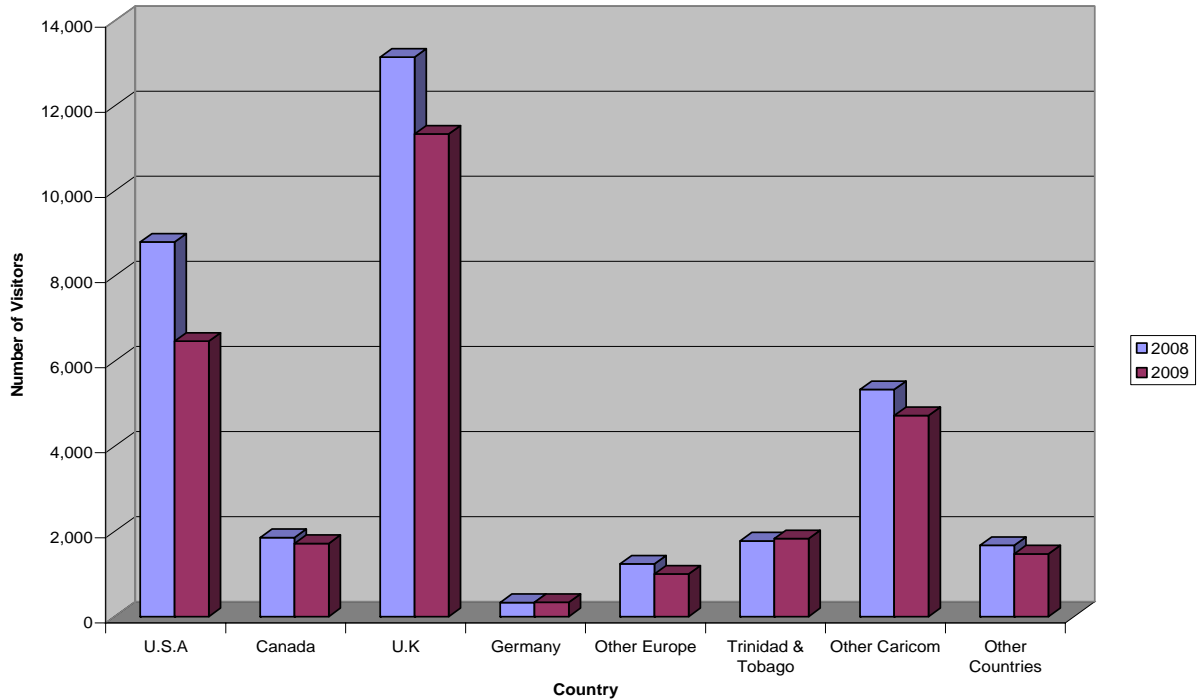

### JANUARY TO SEPTEMBER 2008 AND 2009

Stay-over visitor arrivals for the period January to September 2009 numbered 379,821 which represented a decrease of 49,080 or 11.4 %. Increases in the Canada and Germany markets were 4,481 or 11.0 % and 743 or 17.8 % respectively. Decreases of 18,178 or 17.6 %, 22,296 or 13.6 %, 1,911 or 10.1 %, 1,895 or 8.4 %, 7,612 or

13.6 % or 2,412 or 12.3 % were seen in the U.S.A, U.K, Other Europe, Trinidad & Tobago, Other Caricom and Other Countries markets respectively. Cruise passenger arrivals were 442,723. This represented an increase of 12,059 or 2.8 % when compared to the corresponding period in 2008.

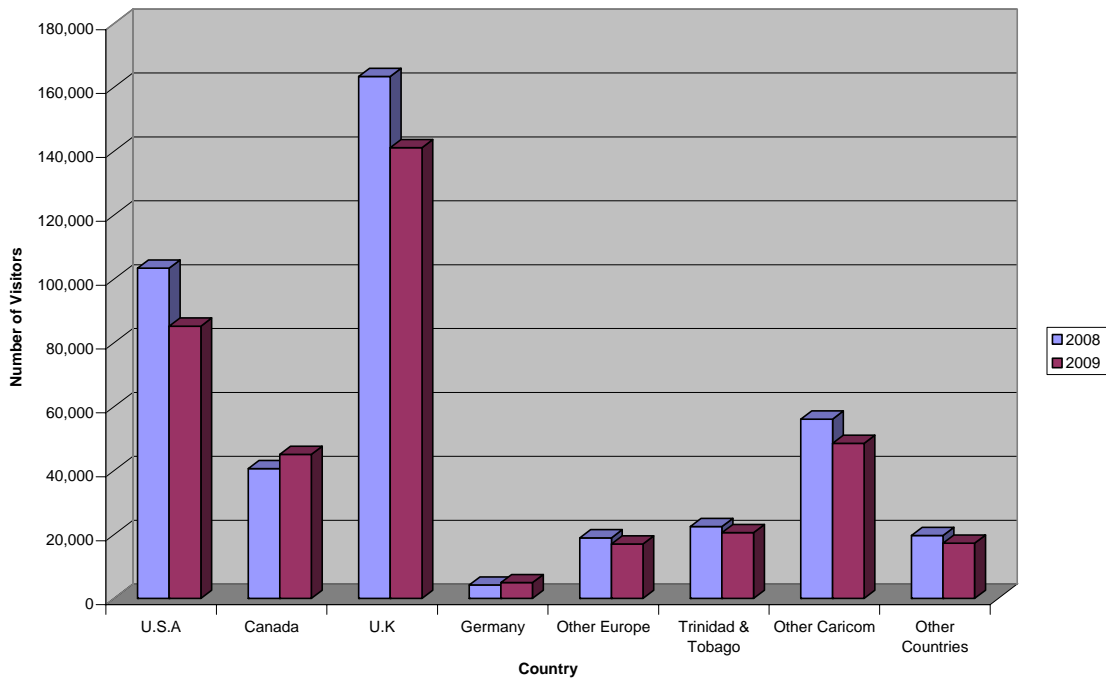
