## **REVIEW OF OVERSEAS TRADE**

During the month of August 2010 imports to Barbados were valued at \$208.7 million, whilst total exports from Barbados were valued at \$50.5 million. This resulted in a visible trade deficit of \$158.2 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$126.9 million for August 2009.

Imports for August 2010 were \$40.1 million less than imports for August 2009, a decrease of 23.8%. Total exports decreased in value by some \$10.8 million or 27.1% of the August 2009 figure. Domestic exports decreased by \$8.1 million or 27.3% over August 2009. Re-exports also decreased by \$2.7 million or 26.5% over the corresponding month 2009.

For the period January - August 2010, the value of imports to Barbados was \$1530.8 million, whilst the value of total exports was \$430.6 million representing an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$1100.2 million as compared to a similar deficit of \$1108.4 million for January - August 2009.

Imports for January - August 2010 were \$9.2 million less than imports for the same period 2009, a decrease of 0.6%. Total exports showed an increase of some \$17.3 million or 4.0% over the January - August 2009 figure. Domestic exports increased by \$20.1 million or 7.1% over January - August 2009. The value of re-exports also increased by \$37.5 million or 25.4% over the corresponding period 2009.

## **CARICOM TRADE**

During the month of August 2010 imports from Caricom countries were valued at \$16.5 million whilst total exports to Caricom were valued at \$19.9 million resulting in a trade deficit of \$3.4 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$0.2 million for August 2009.

Caricom imports for August 2010 were \$4.5 million less than Caricom imports for August 2009, a decrease of 27.4%. Total exports to Caricom for August 2010 were \$1.0 million less than total exports for August 2009, a decrease of 4.8%. Domestic exports decreased by \$1.9 million or 11.9% over the corresponding month 2009. The value of re-exports also decreased by \$1.0 million or 25.6% of the August 2009 figure.

For the period January - August 2010 total imports from Caricom were valued at \$168.0 million whilst total exports were \$169.3 million resulting in an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$0.1 million as compared with a deficit of \$0.9 million for the same period of 2009.

During this period Caricom imports were approximately \$1.3 million less than those over the same period in 2009, a decrease of 0.8%. Total exports to Caricom for January - August 2009 were \$2.1 million more than total exports for the corresponding period 2009, an increase of 1.3%. Domestic exports increased by \$2.4 million or 1.8% over the same period 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$4.5 million or 11.9% over the January - August 2009 figure.

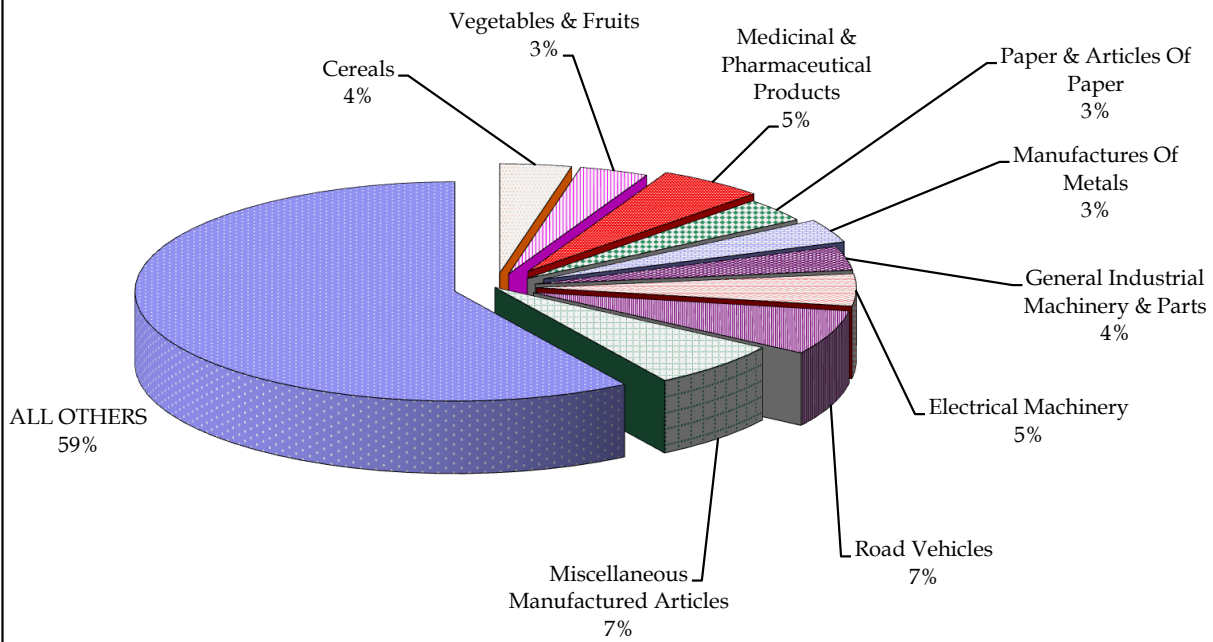

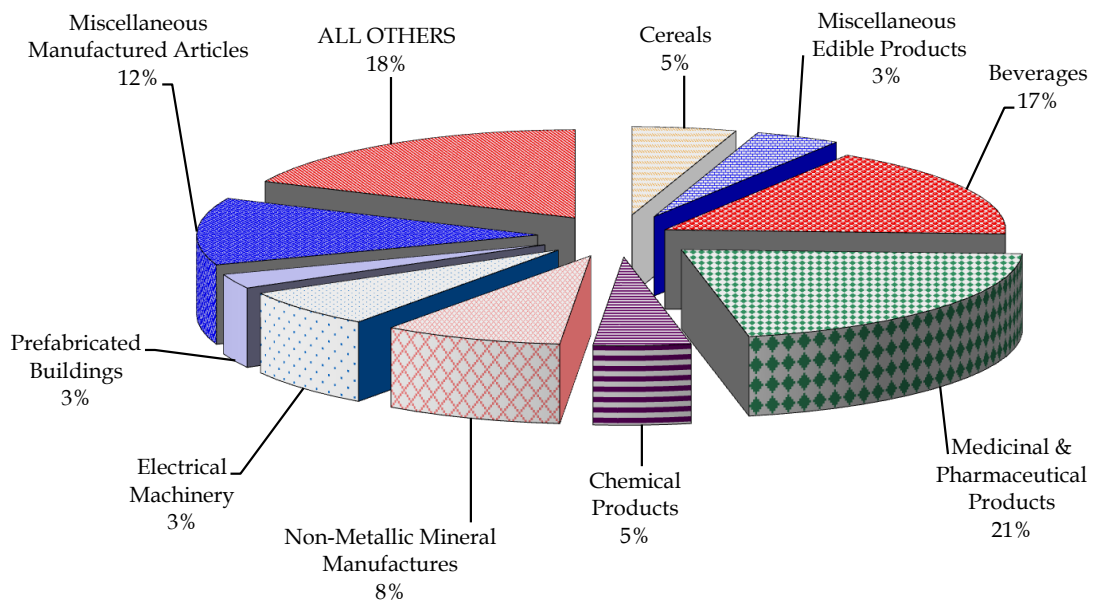

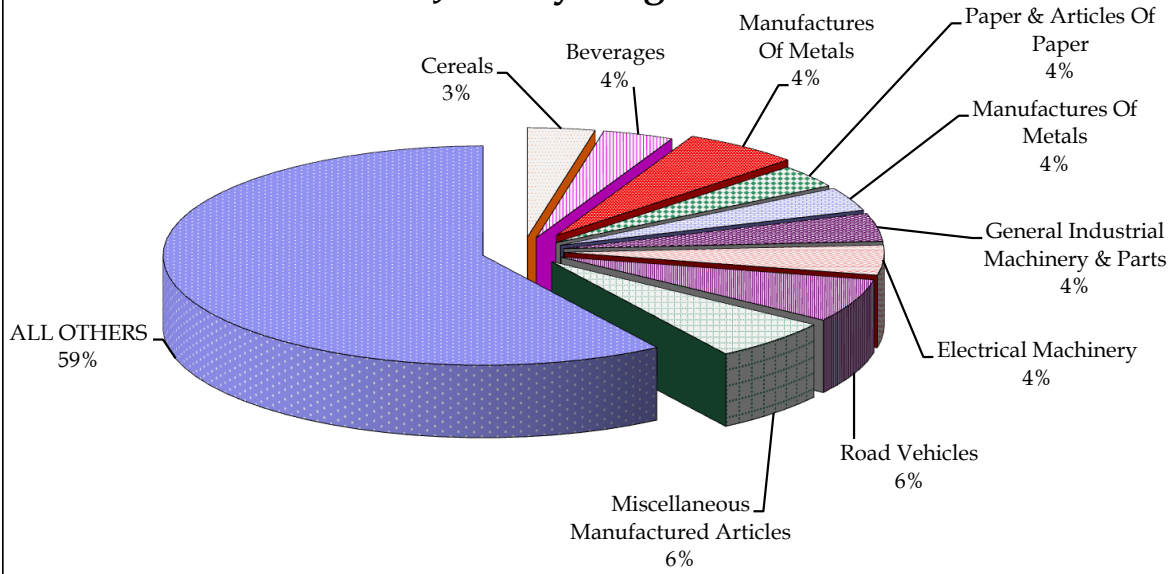

### Principal Domestic Exports January- August 2010

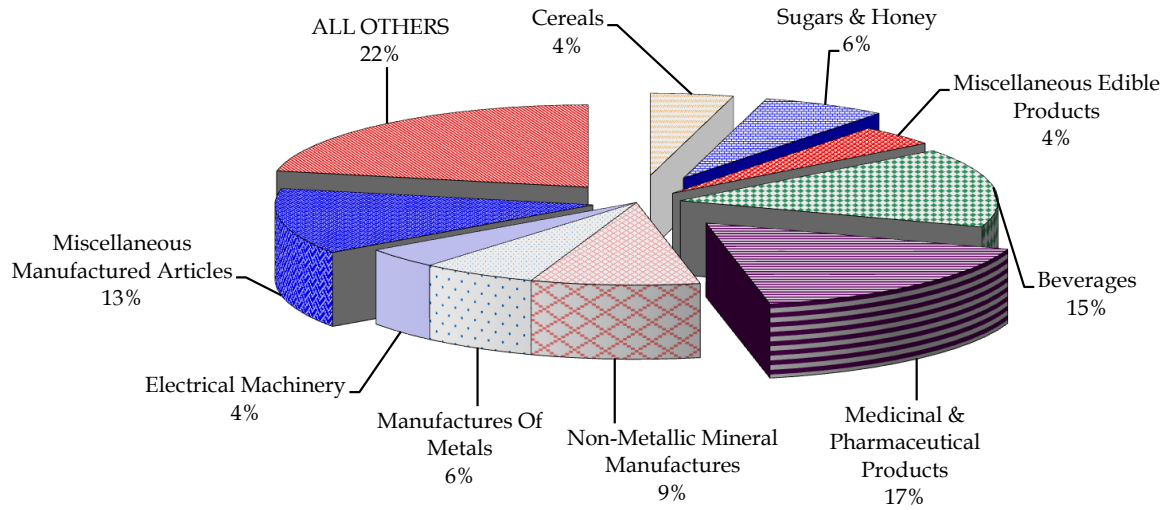

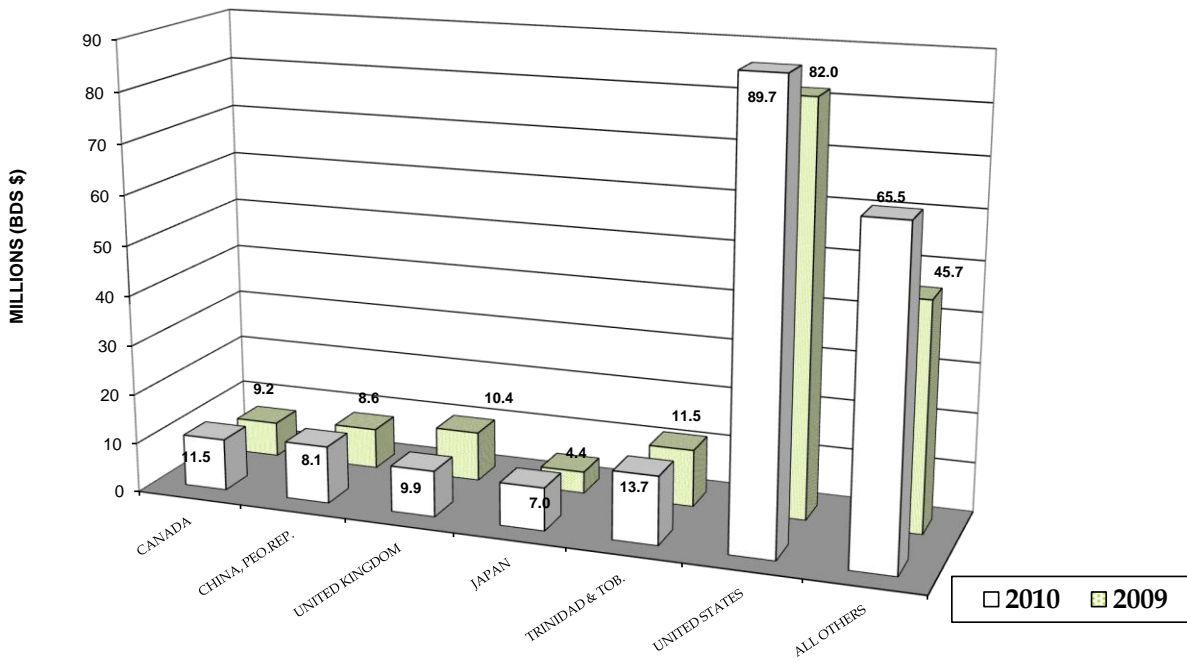

AUGUST 2010 WITH THE CORRESPONDING MONTH OF 2009

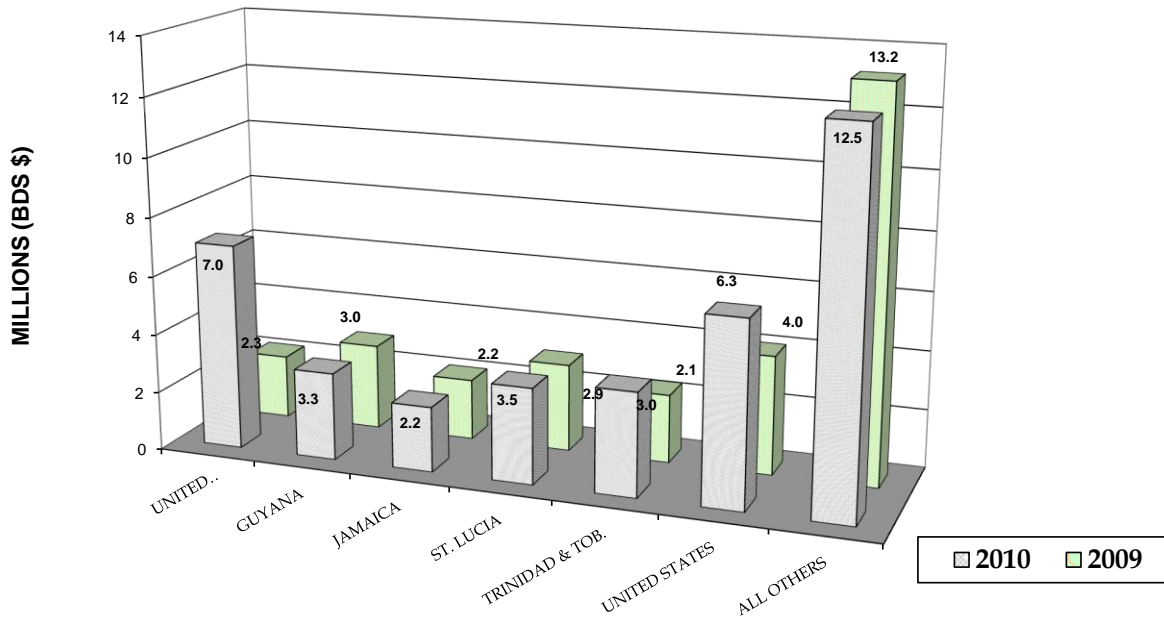

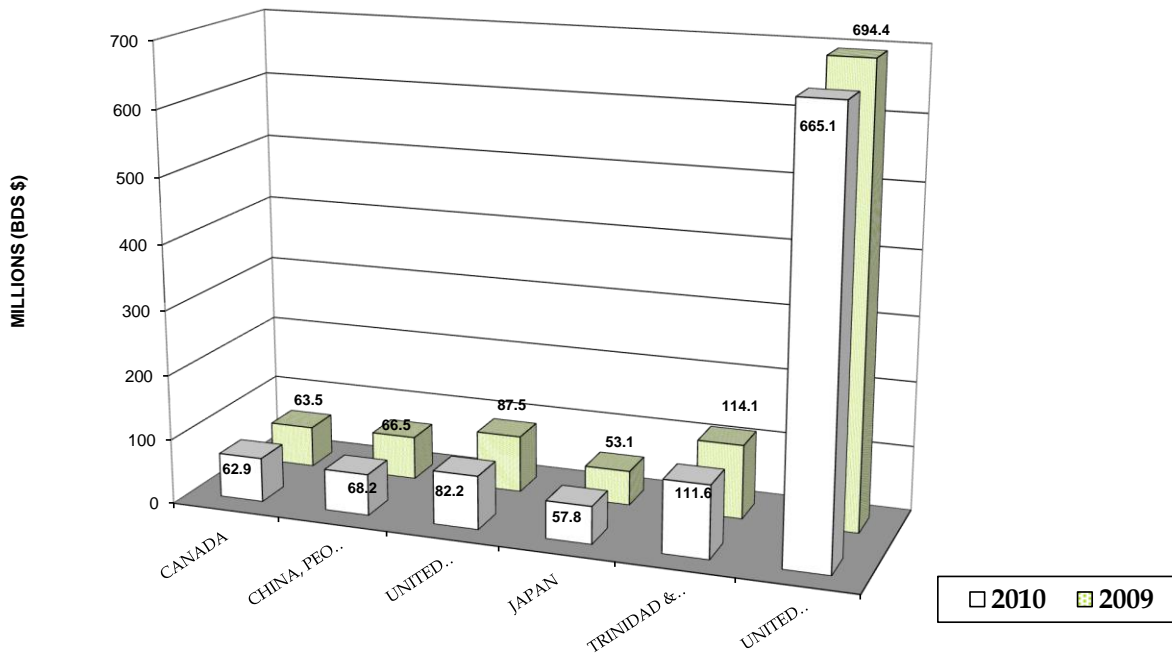

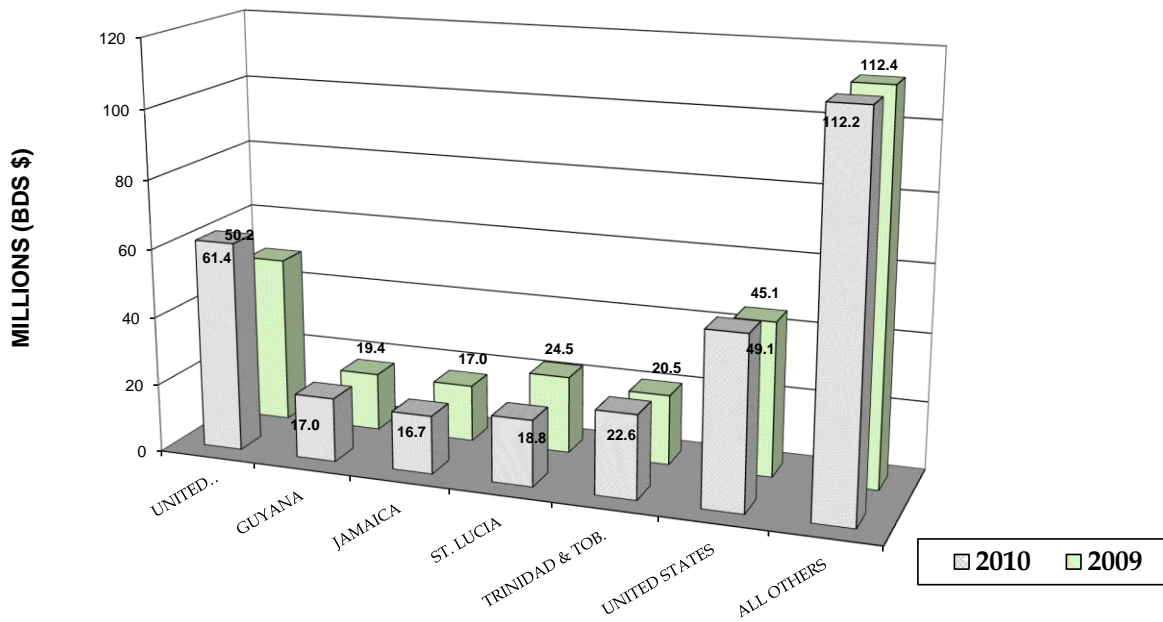

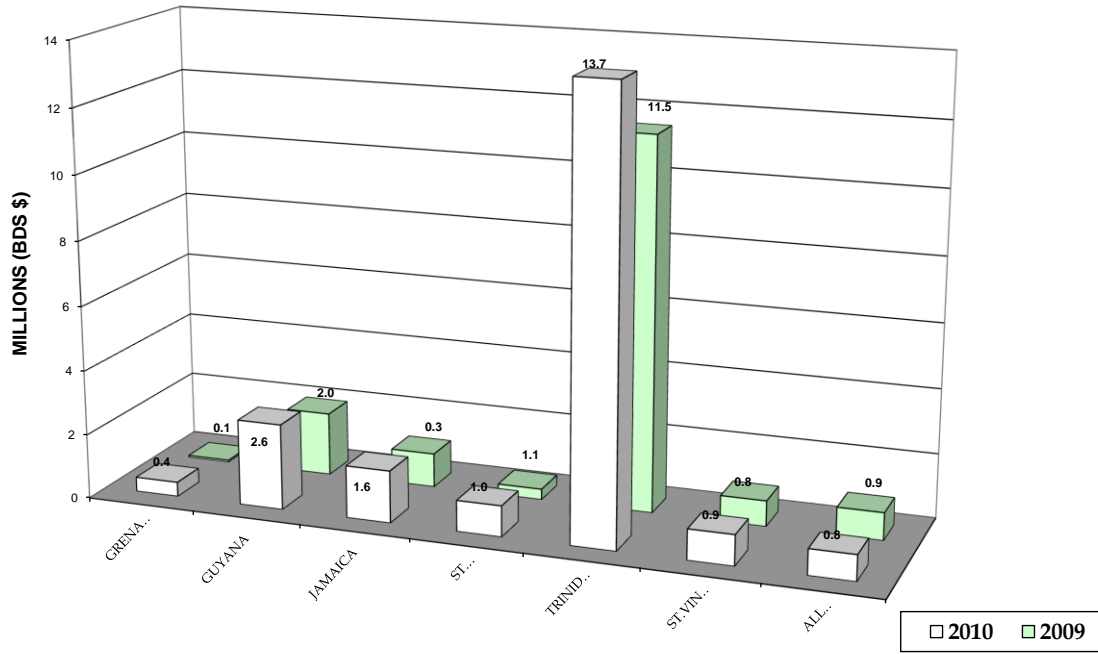

JUNE 2007 WITH THE CORRESPONDING MONTH OF 2006

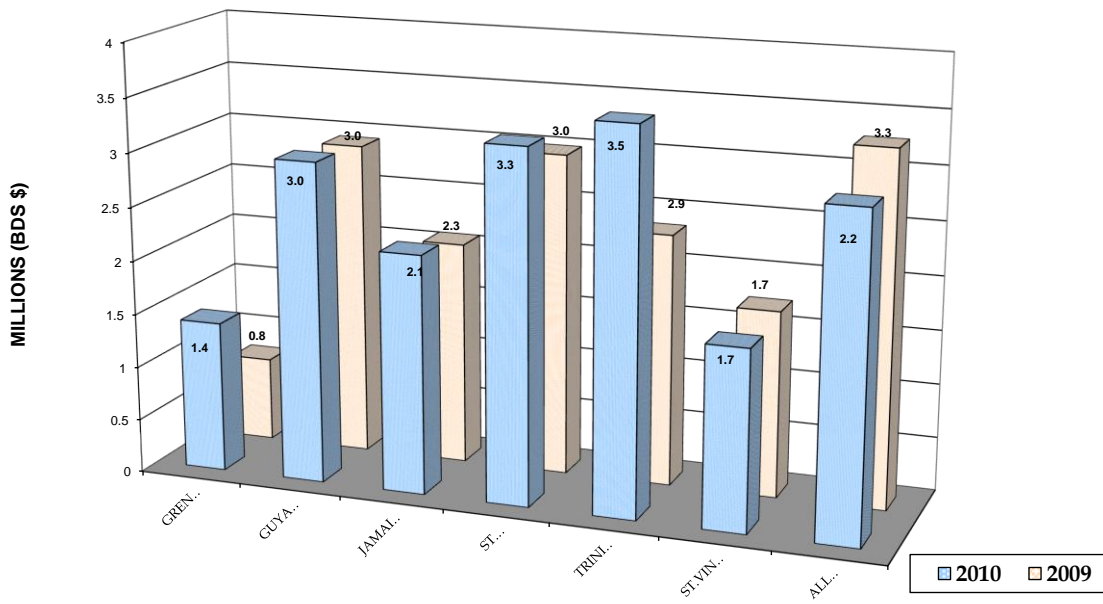

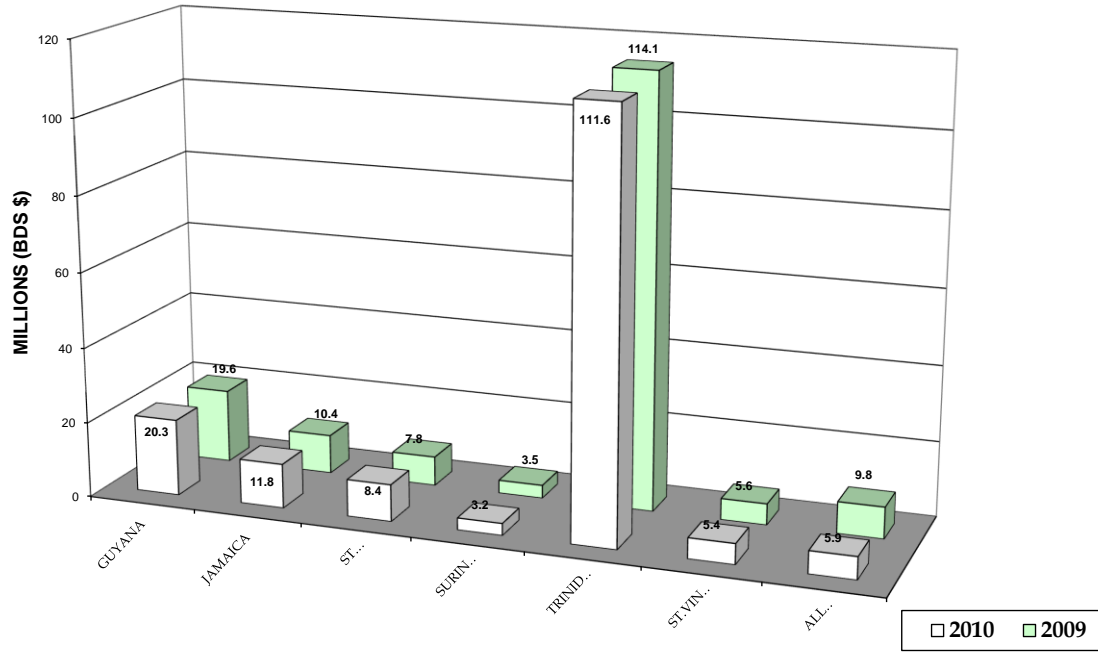

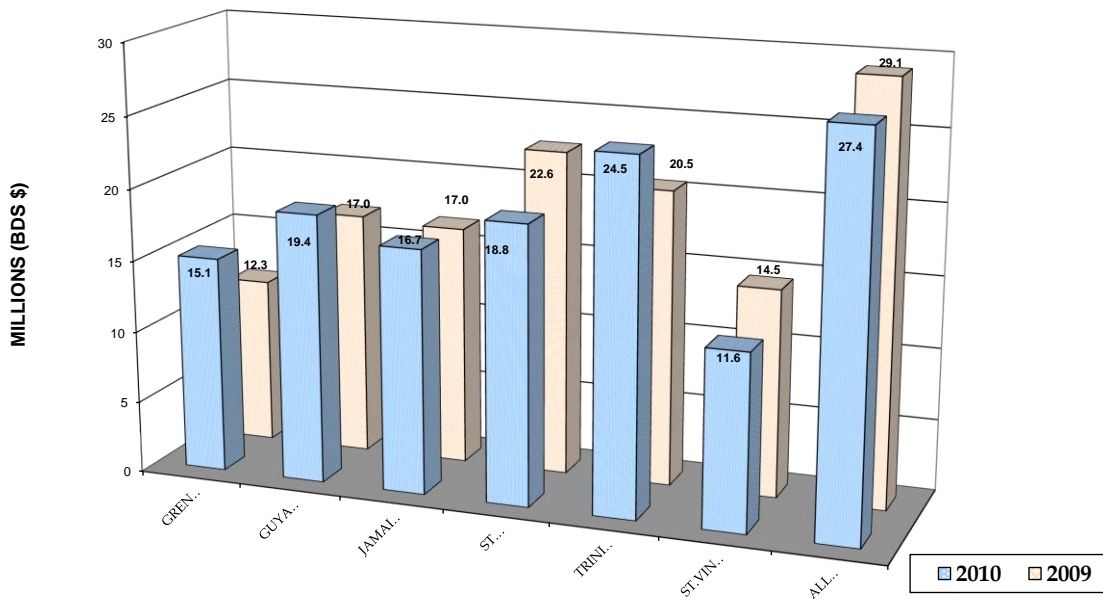
