## **REVIEW OF OVERSEAS TRADE**

During the month of June 2010 imports to Barbados were valued at \$202.6 million, whilst total exports from Barbados were valued at \$49.3 million. This resulted in a visible trade deficit of \$153.3 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$128.3 million for 2009.

Imports for June 2010 were \$14.8 million less than imports for June 2009, a decrease of 7.9%. Total exports decreased in value by some \$10.3 million or 17.2% of the 2009 figure. Domestic exports decreased by \$13.1 million or 26.4% over June 2009. The value of re-exports also decreased by \$2.8 million or 28.1% over the corresponding month 2008.

For the period January - June 2010, the value of imports to Barbados was \$1110.0 million, whilst the value of total exports was \$313.1 million representing an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$796.9million as compared to a similar deficit of \$807.5 million for January - June 2009.

Imports for January - June 2010 were \$44.1 million less than imports for the same period 2009, a decrease of 3.3%. Total exports showed a decrease of some \$33.4 million or 9.6% over the January - June 2009 figure. Domestic exports increased by \$4.7 million or 2.1% over January - June 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased \$38.1 million or 30.3% over the corresponding period 2009.

## **CARICOM TRADE**

During the month of June 2010 imports from Caricom countries were valued at 23.6 million whilst total exports to Caricom were valued at \$20.3 million resulting in a trade deficit of \$3.2 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$3.6 million for June 2009.

Caricom imports for June 2010 were \$1.4 million less than Caricom imports for June 2009, a decrease of 6.5%. Total exports to Caricom for June 2010 were \$1.8million less than total exports for June 2009, a decrease of 9.7%. Domestic exports decreased by \$0.9 million or 5.6% over the corresponding month 2009. The value of re-exports also decreased by \$0.9 million or 36.2 % of the June 2009 figure.

For the period January - June 2010 total imports from Caricom were valued at \$122.6 million whilst total exports were \$123.1 million resulting in an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$5.4 million as compared with a deficit of \$4.2 million for the same period of 2009.

During this period Caricom imports were approximately \$8.0 million less than those over the same period in 2009, a decrease of 6.1%. Total exports to Caricom for January - June 2010 were \$5.4 million less than total exports for the corresponding period 2009, a decrease of 4.2%. Domestic exports increased by \$0.7 million or 0.8% over the same period 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$4.6 million or 15.3% over the January - June 2009 figure.

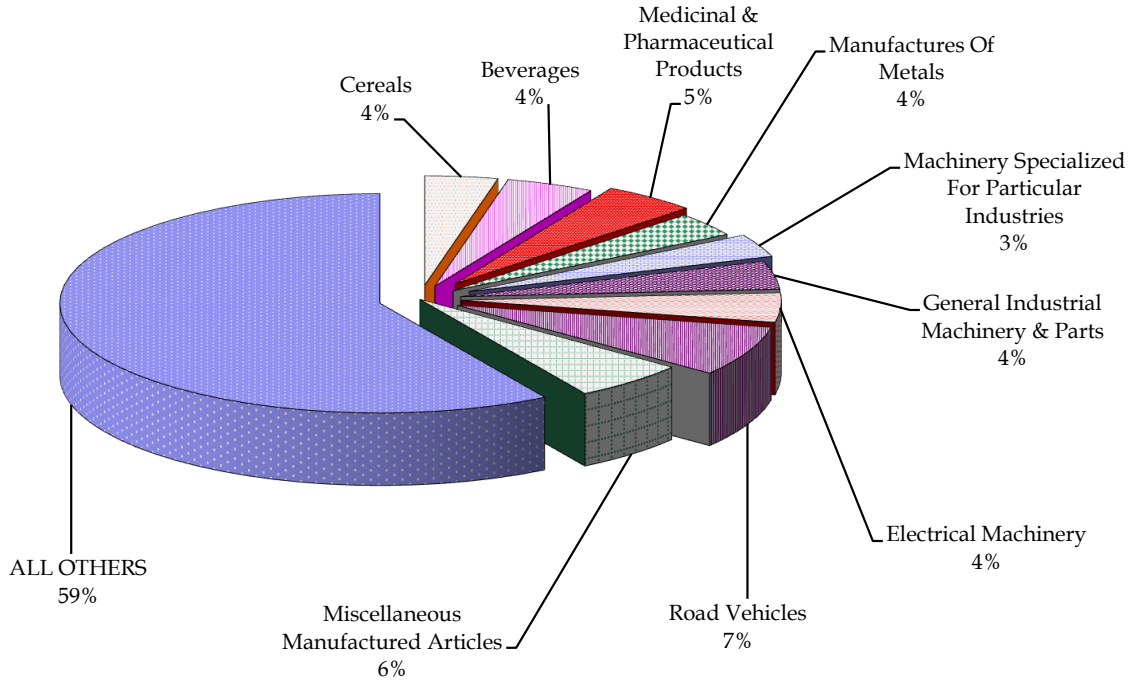

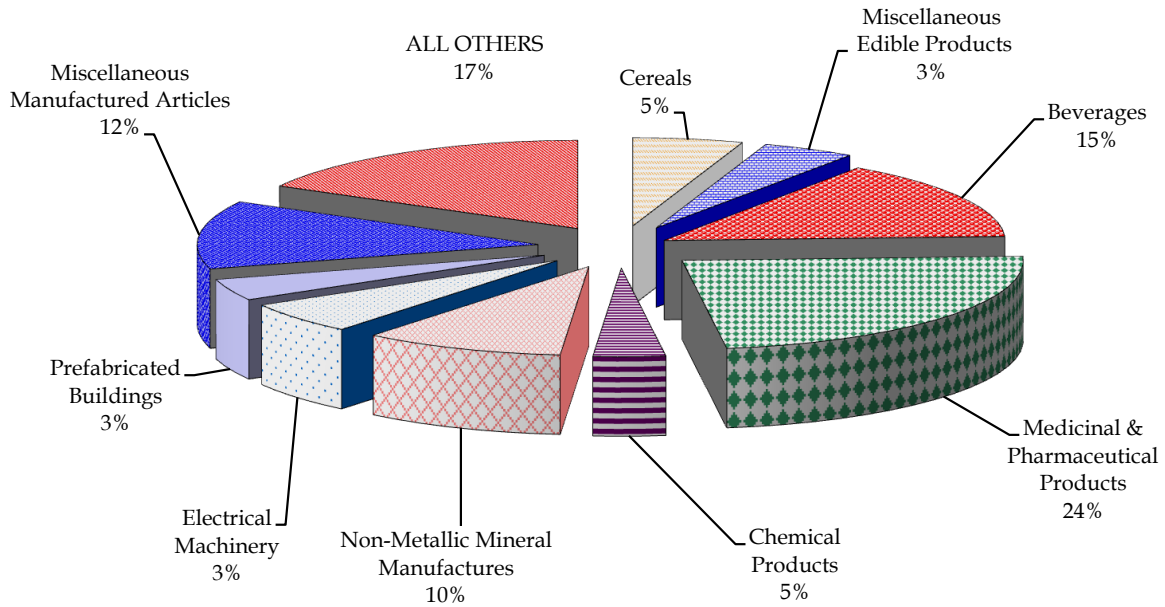

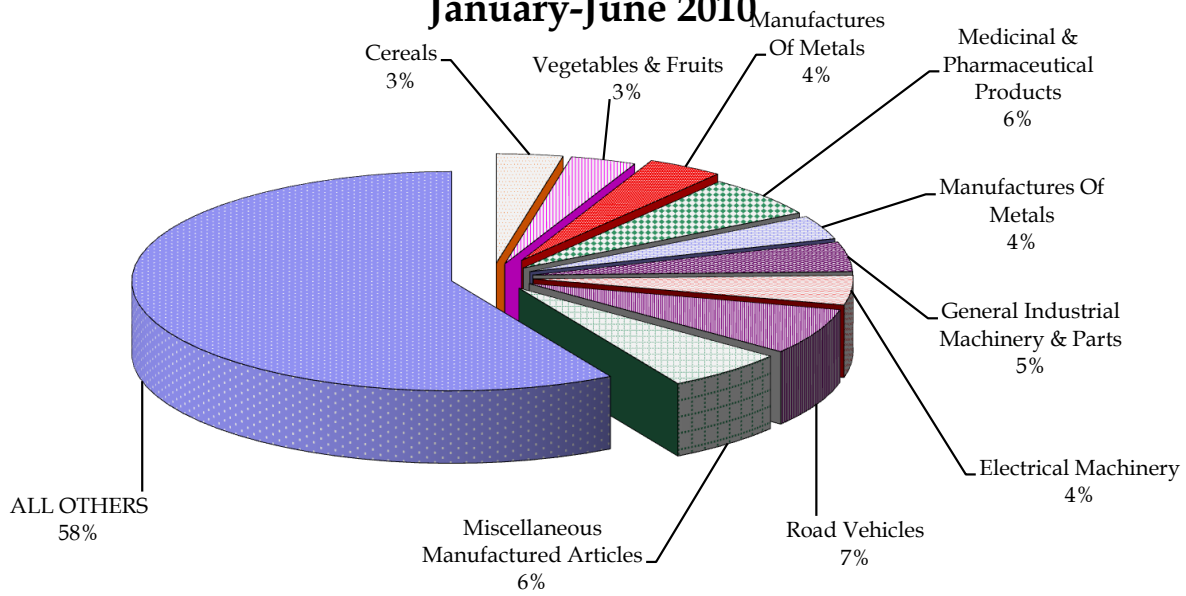

### Principal Domestic Exports January- June 2010

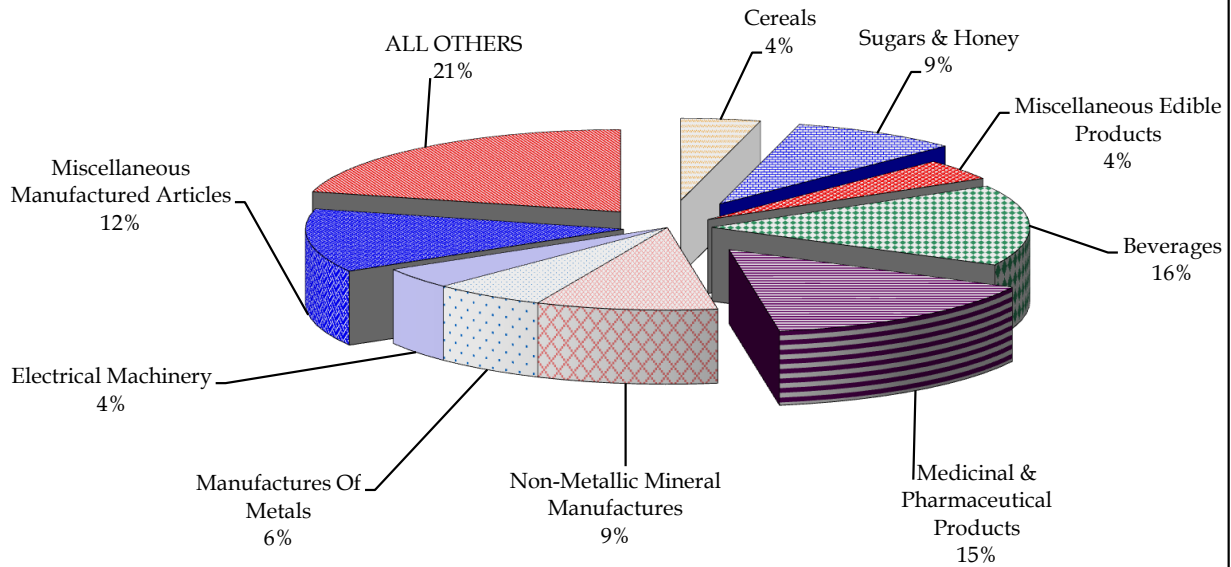

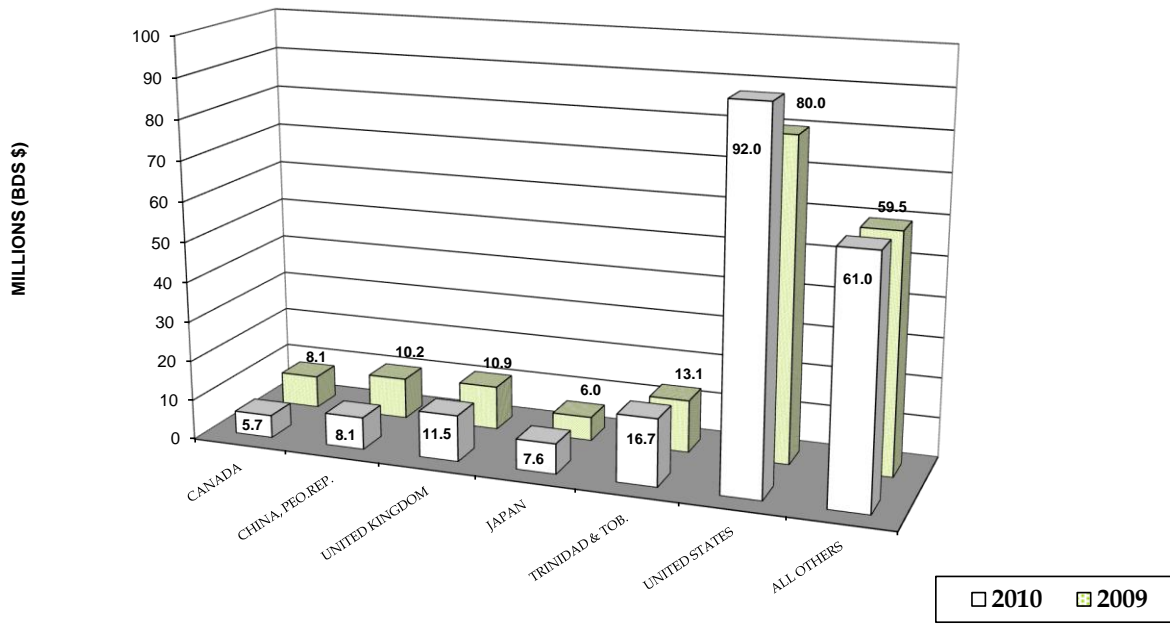

JUNE 2010 WITH THE CORRESPONDING MONTH OF 2009

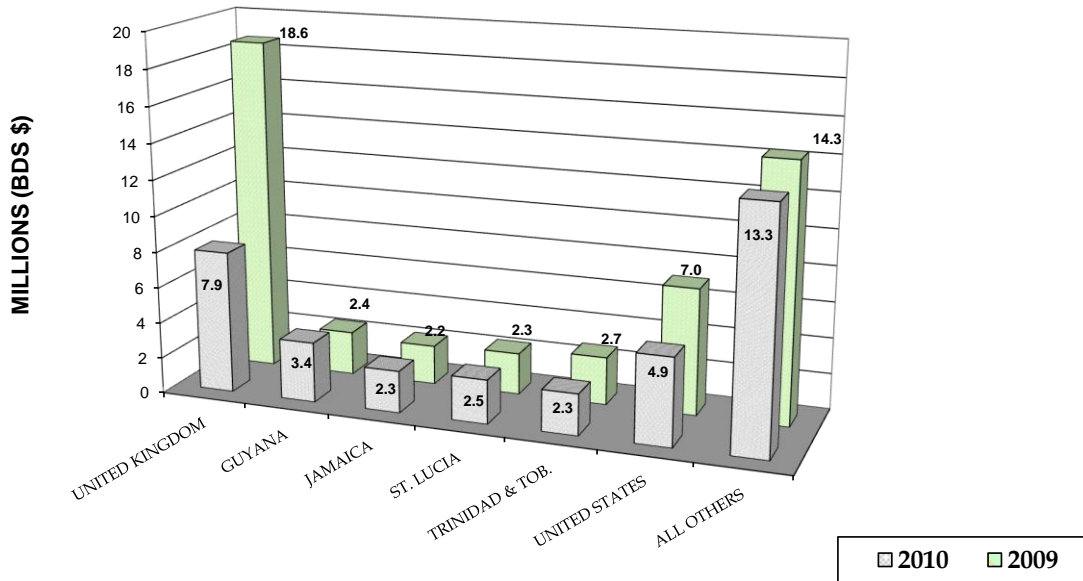

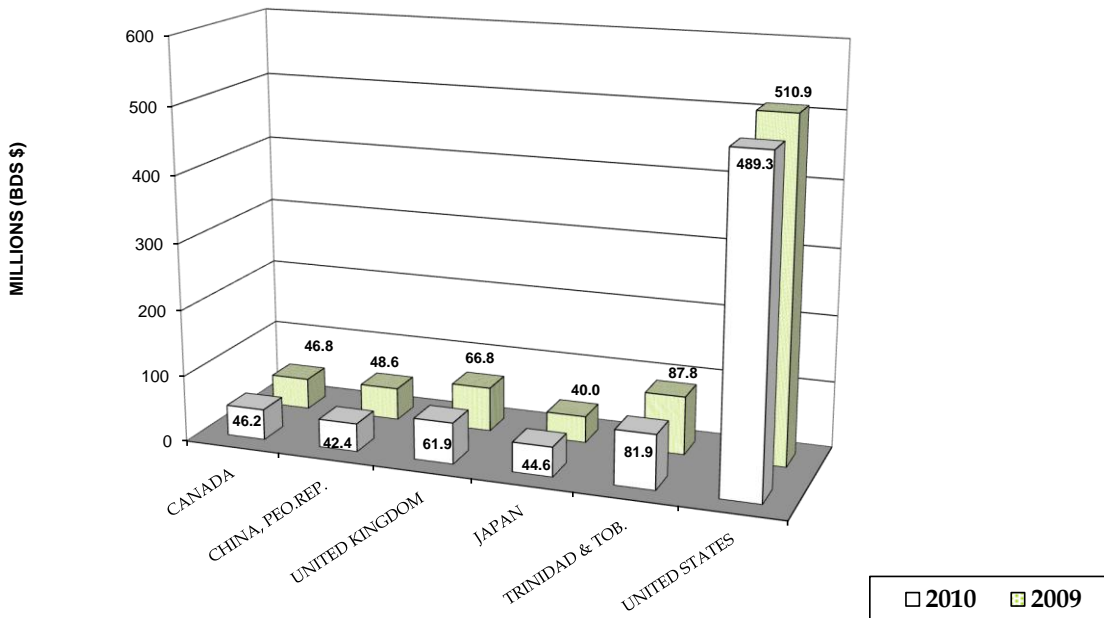

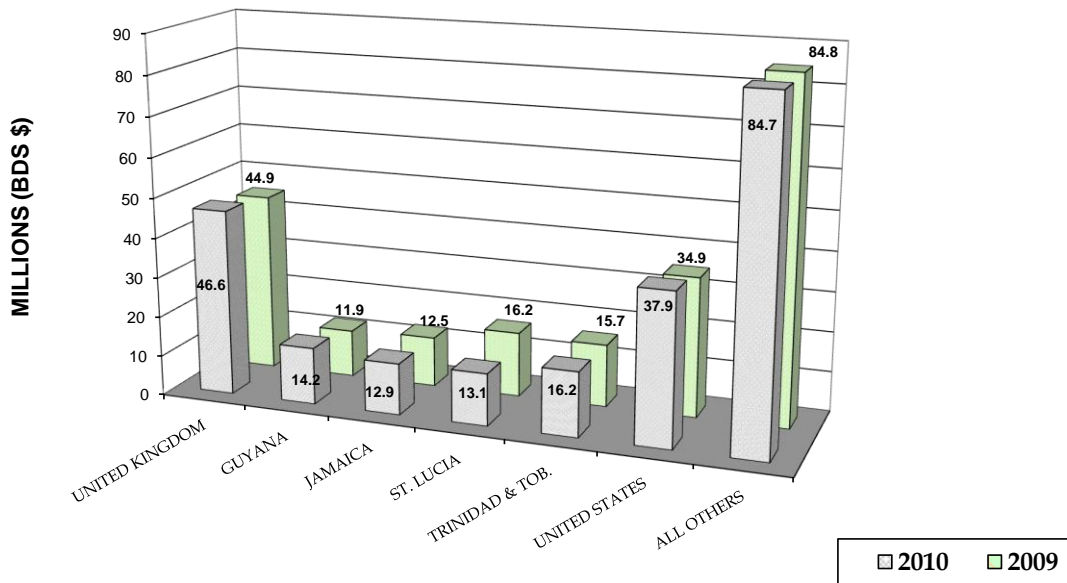

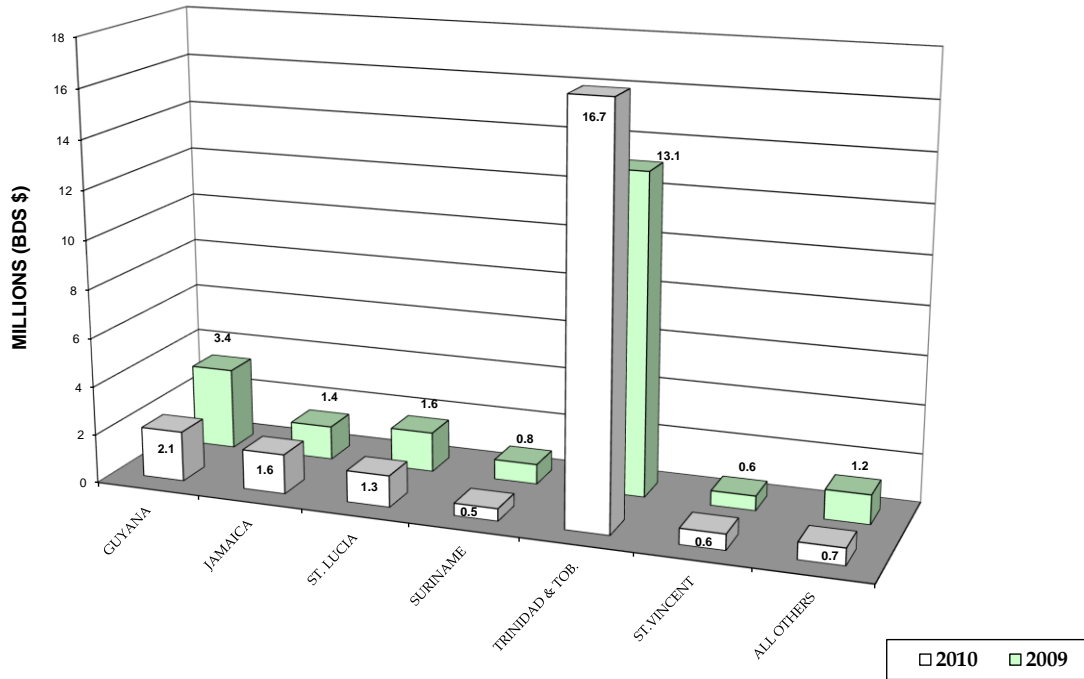

JUNE 2010 WITH THE CORRESPONDING MONTH OF 2009

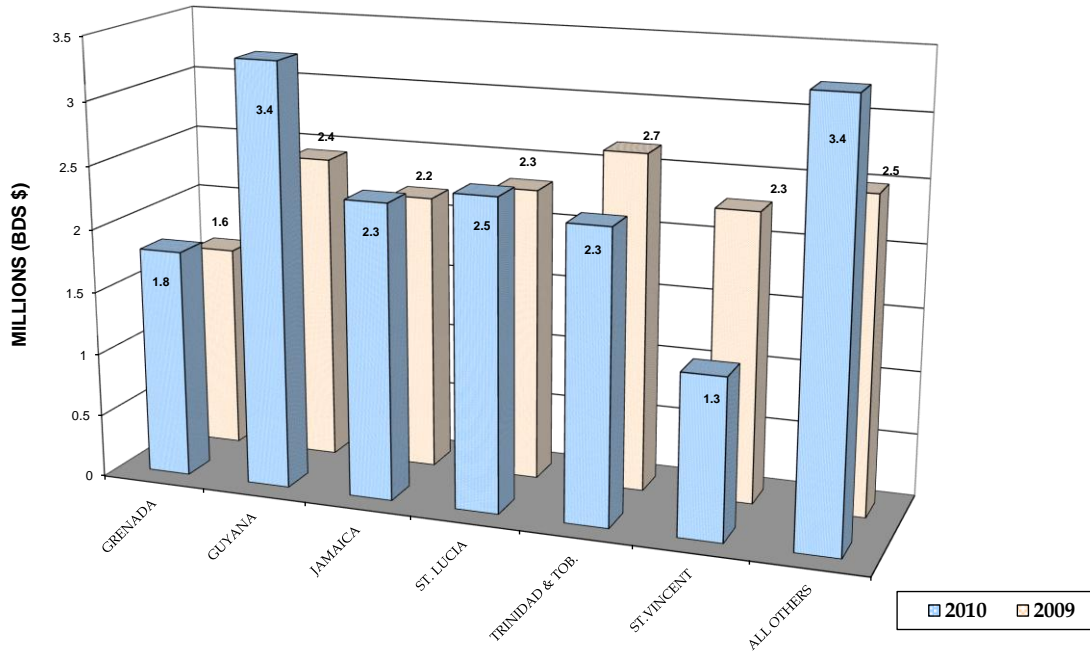

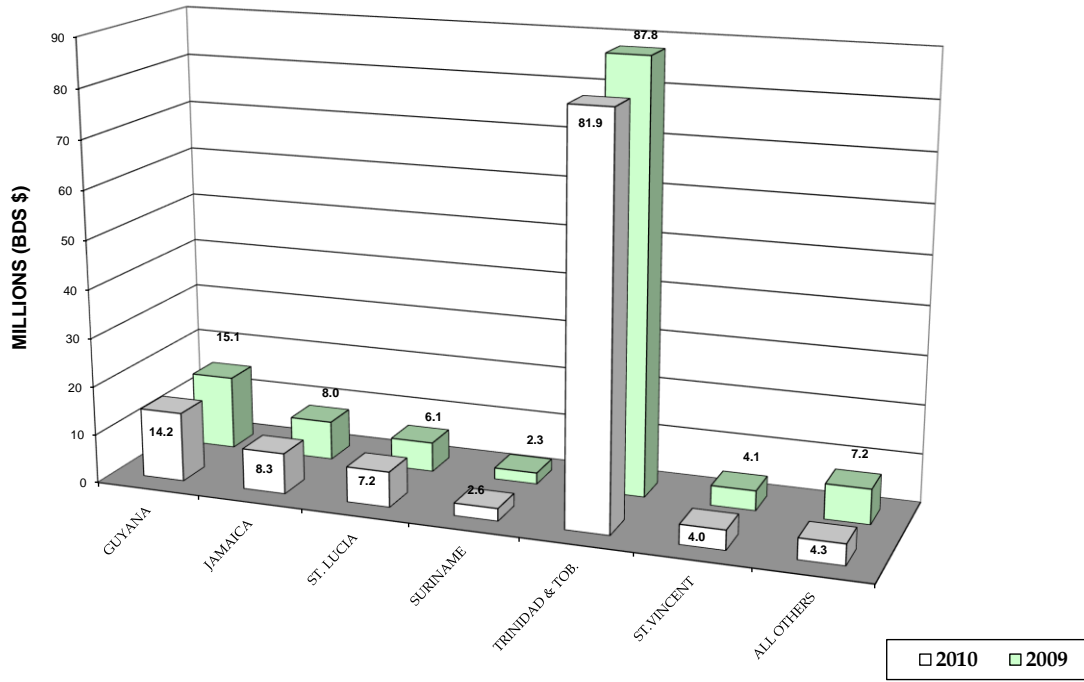

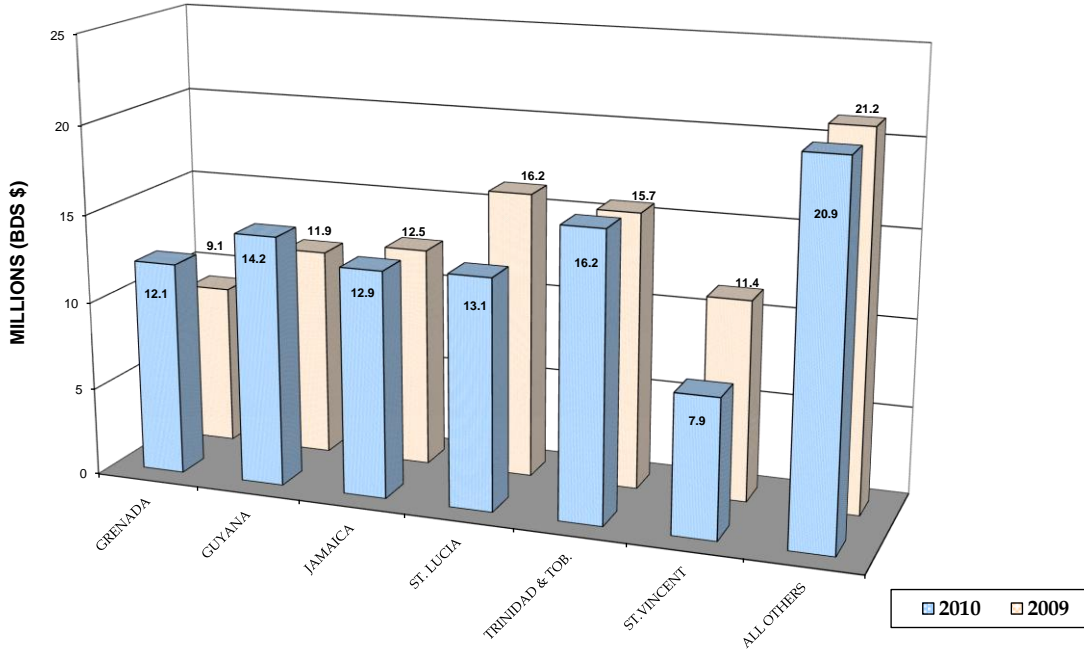
