## **REVIEW OF OVERSEAS TRADE**

During the month of May 2010 imports to Barbados were valued at \$183.7 million, whilst total exports from Barbados were valued at \$64.8 million. This resulted in a visible trade deficit of \$118.9 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$120.0 million for May 2009.

Imports for May 2010 were \$8.7 million less than imports for May 2009, a decrease of 4.5%. Total exports decreased in value by some \$7.6 million or 10.5% of the May 2009 figure. Domestic exports increased by \$18.1 million or 55.8% over May 2009. However, re-exports decreased by \$25.7 million or 64.5% over the corresponding month 2009.

For the period January - May 2010 the value of imports to Barbados was \$907.3 million, whilst the value of total exports was \$263.7 million representing an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$643.6 million as compared to a similar deficit of \$679.3 million for January - May 2009.

Imports for January - May 2010 were \$58.8 million less than imports for the same period 2009, a decrease of 6.1%. Total exports showed a decrease of some \$23.2 million or 8.1% over the January - May 2009 figure. Domestic exports increased by \$17.8 million or 10.4% over January - May 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$40.9 million or 35.4% over the corresponding period 2009.

## **CARICOM TRADE**

During the month of May 2010 imports from Caricom countries were valued at \$21.6 million whilst total exports to Caricom were valued at \$19.0 million resulting in a trade deficit of \$2.6 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$3.7 million for May 2009.

Caricom imports for May 2010 were \$1.6 million less than Caricom imports for May 2009, a decrease of 6.8%. Total exports to Caricom for May 2010 were \$0.5 million less than total exports for May 2009, a decrease of 2.4%. Domestic exports decreased by \$1.8 million or 11.1% over the corresponding month 2009. The value of re-exports also decreased by \$1.3 million or 40.7% of the May 2009 figure.

For the period January - May 2010 total imports from Caricom were valued at \$98.9 million whilst total exports were \$102.7 million resulting in an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$9.4 million as compared with a deficit of \$8.7 million for the same period of 2009.

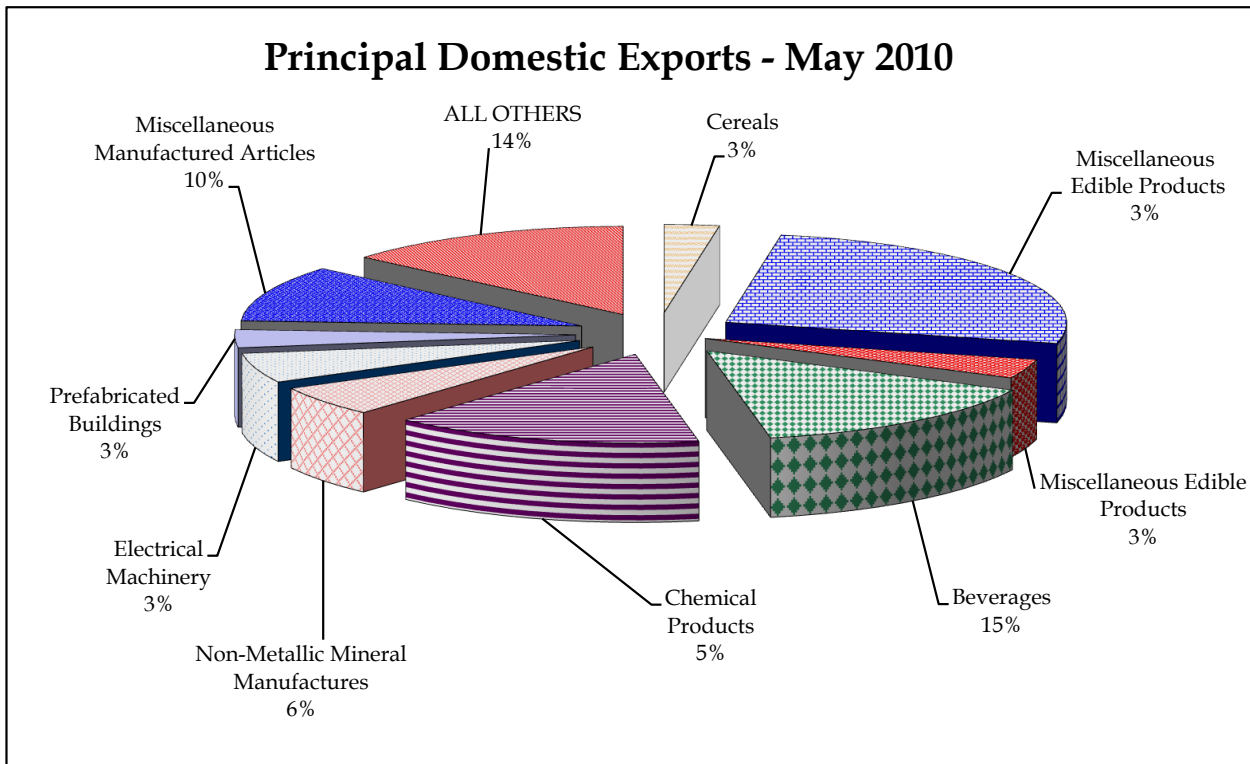
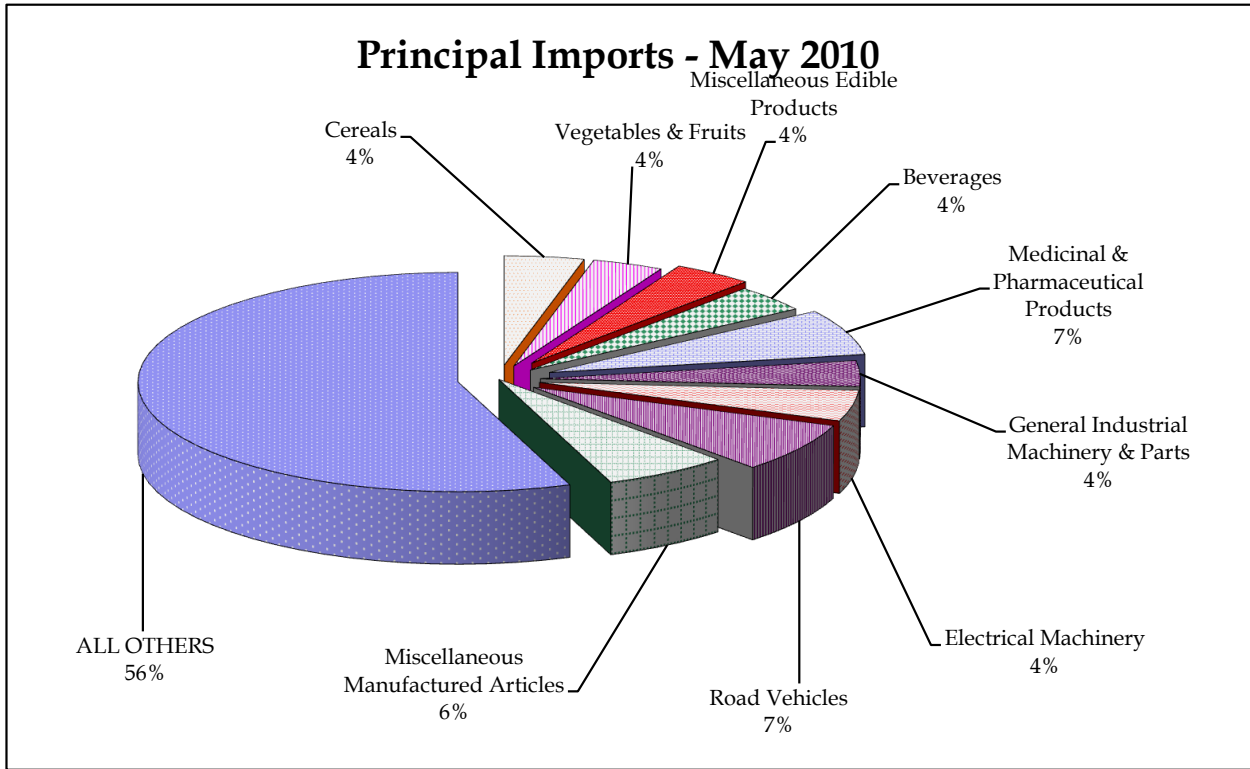
During this period Caricom imports were approximately \$9.4 million less than those over the same period in 2009, a decrease of 8.7%. Total exports to Caricom for January - May 2010 were \$7.2 million less than total exports for the corresponding period 2009, a decrease of 6.5%. Domestic exports increased by \$1.6 million or 2.0% over the same period 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$5.6 million or 19.9% over the January - May 2009 figure

JANUARY - MAY 2010 WITH THE CORRESPONDING PERIOD OF 2009**

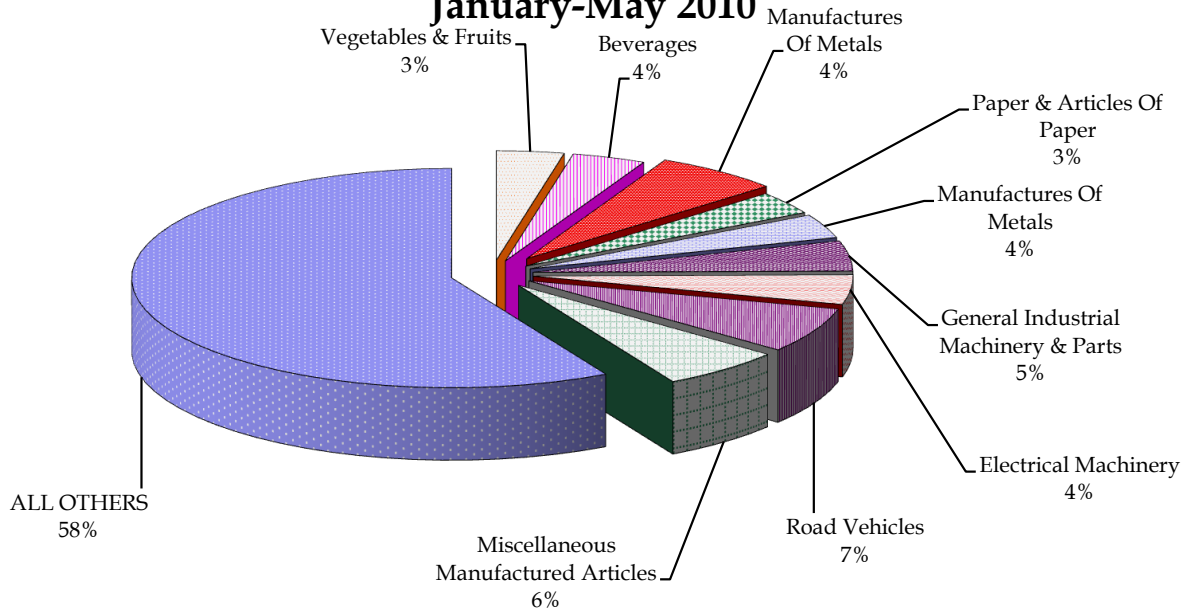

### Principal Domestic Exports January- May 2010

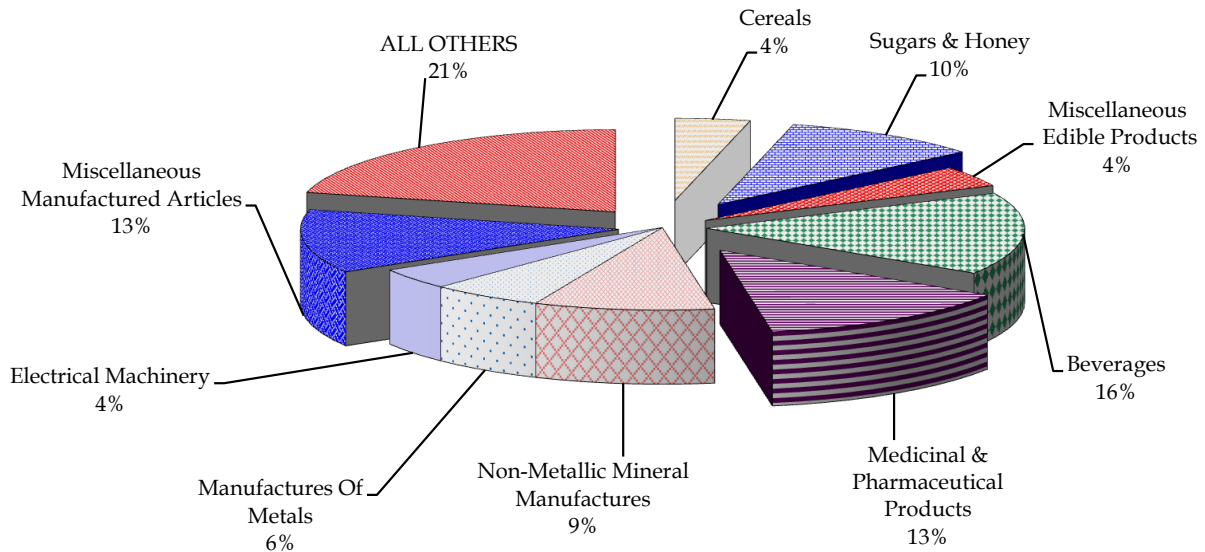

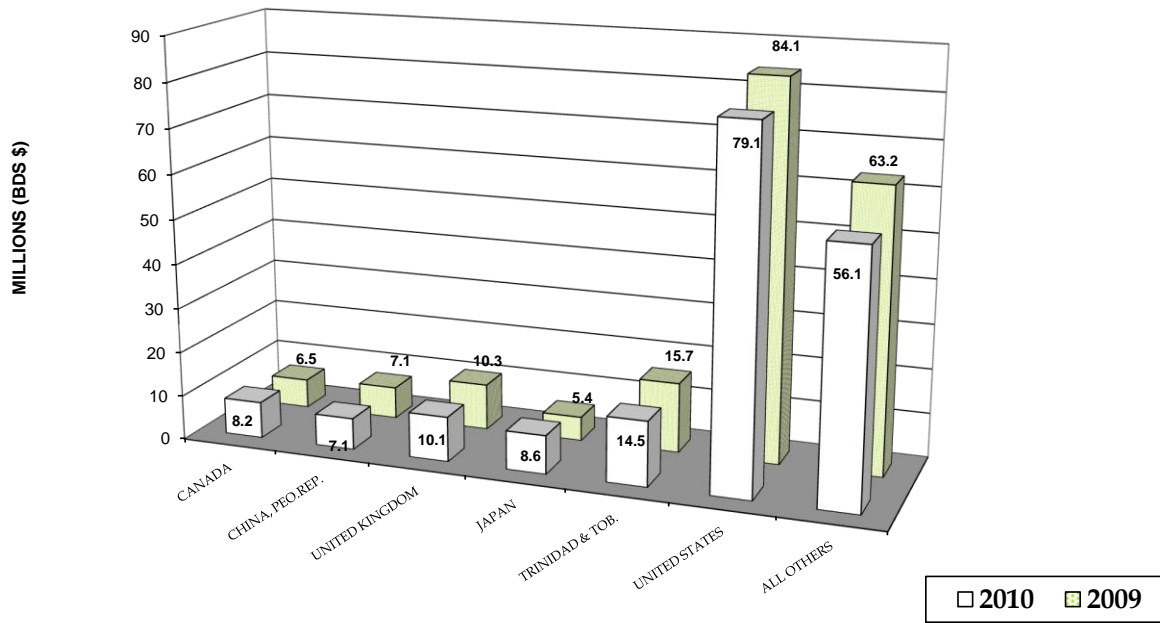

MAY 2010 WITH THE CORRESPONDING MONTH OF 2009

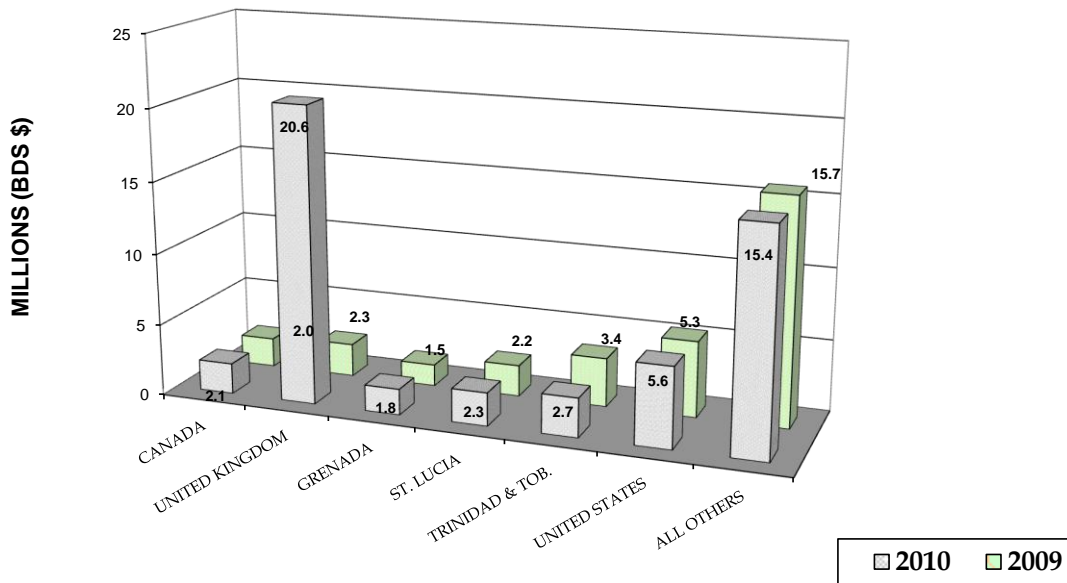

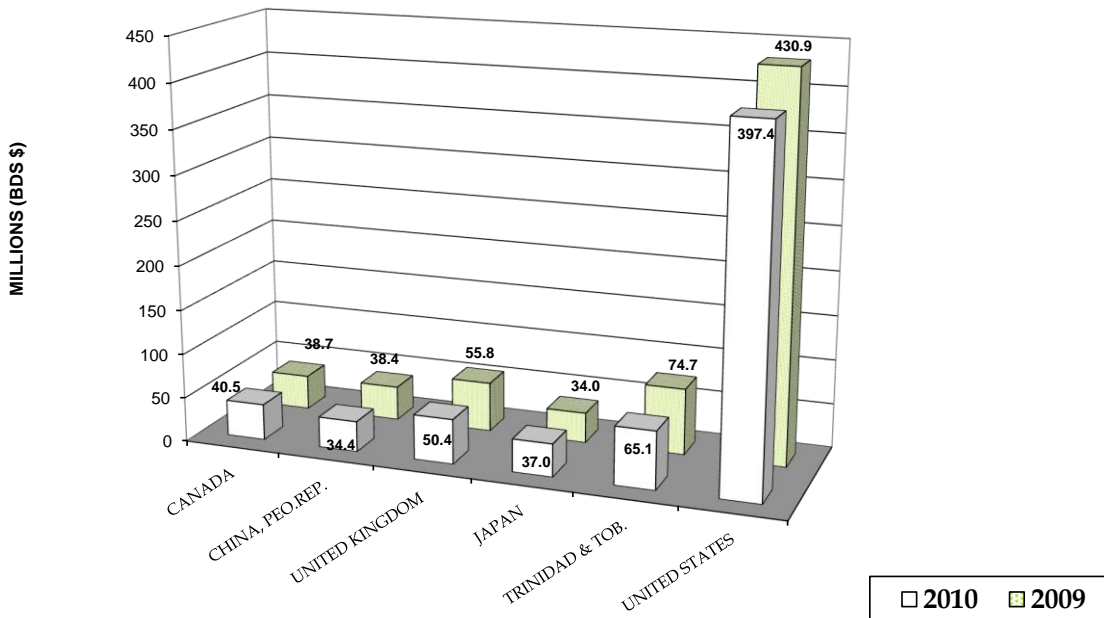

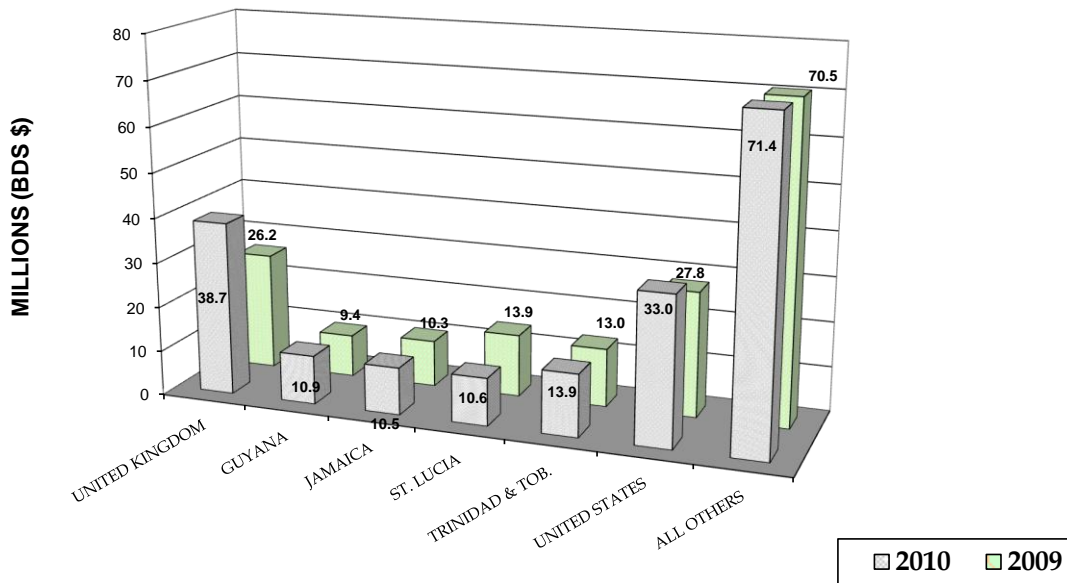

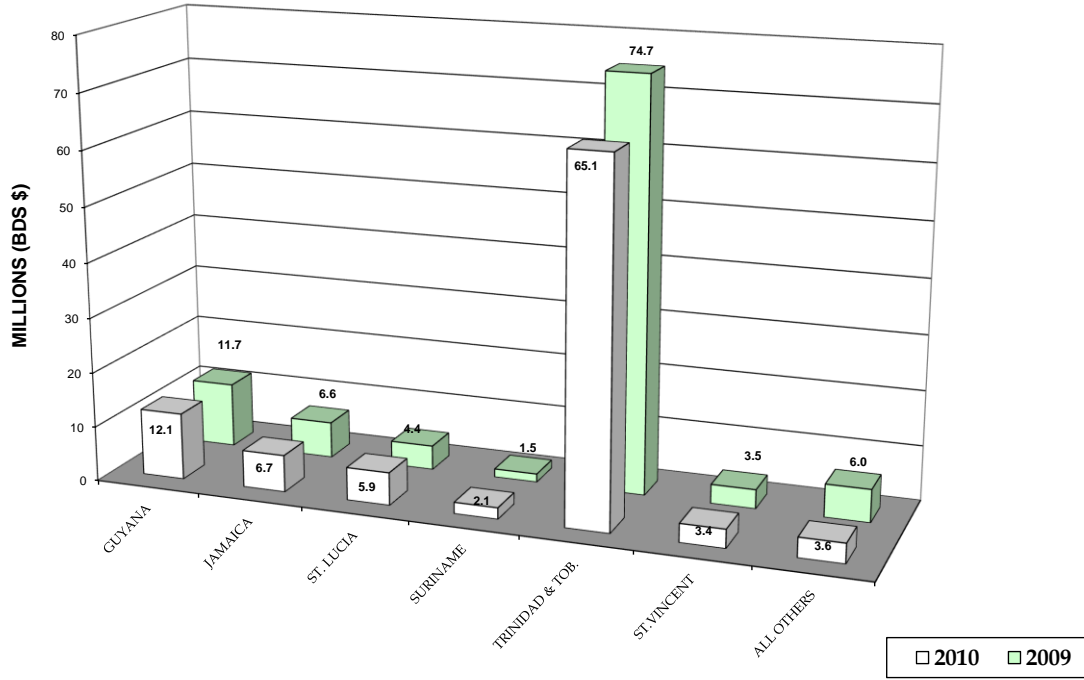

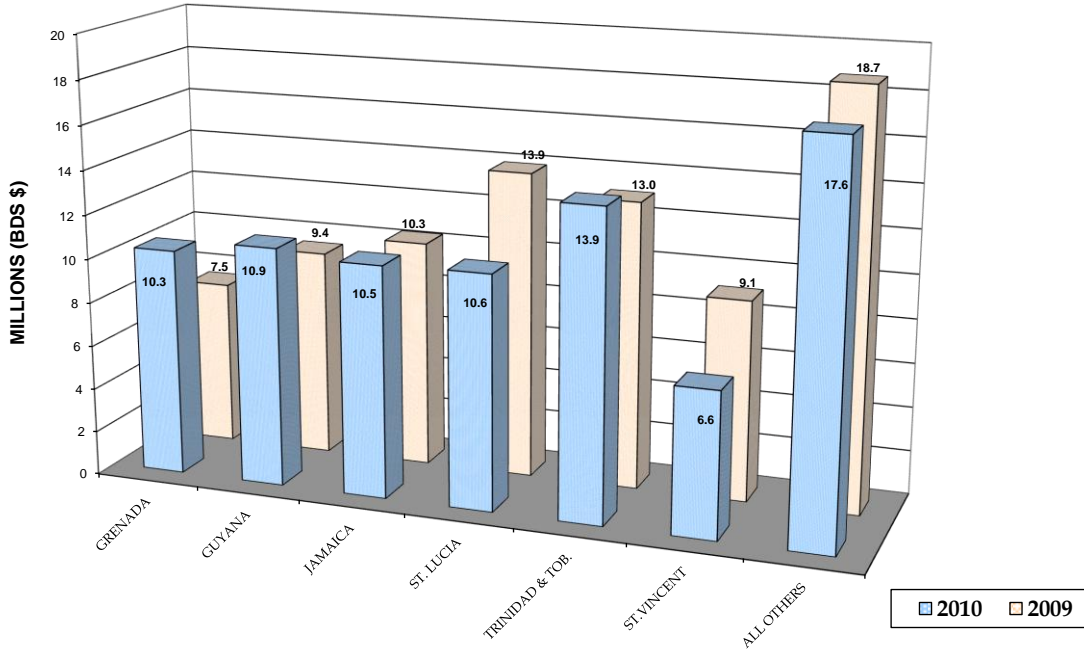
