OVERSEAS TRADE

OCTOBER 2010

REVIEW OF OVERSEAS TRADE

During the month of October 2010 imports to Barbados were valued at \$199.2 million, whilst total exports from Barbados were valued at \$48.9 million. This resulted in a visible trade deficit of \$150.2 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$155.7 million for October 2009.

Imports for October 2010 were \$5.0 million less than imports for October 2009, a decrease of 2.4%. Total exports decreased in value by some \$0.5 million or 1.1% of the October 2009 figure. Domestic exports decreased by \$3.0 million or 8.6% over October 2009. However, re-exports decreased by \$2.5 million or 19.1% over the corresponding month 2009.

For the period January - October 2010, the value of imports to Barbados was \$1928.6 million, whilst the value of total exports was \$515.6 million representing an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$1412.6 million as compared to a similar deficit of \$1395.4 million for January - October 2009.

Imports for January - October 2010 were \$8.1 million less than imports for the same period 2009, a decrease of 0.4%. Total exports showed an increase of some \$9.2 million or 1.7% over the January - October 2009 figure. Domestic exports decreased by \$33.4 million or 9.5% over January - October 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$42.5 million or 24.7% over the corresponding period 2009.

CARICOM TRADE

During the month of October 2010 imports from Caricom countries were valued at \$22.3 million whilst total exports to Caricom were valued at \$21.0 million resulting in a trade deficit of \$1.3 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$1.6 million for October 2009.

Caricom imports for October 2010 were \$1.8 million less than Caricom imports for October 2009 a decrease of 7.6%. Total exports to Caricom for October 2010 were \$1.5 million less than total exports for October 2009, a decrease of 6.7%. Domestic exports decreased by \$1.6 million or 8.2% over the corresponding month 2009. The value of re-exports also decreased by \$0.1 million or 2.4% of the October 2009 figure.

For the period January - October 2010 total imports from Caricom were valued at \$211.7 million whilst total exports were \$210.3 million resulting in an accumulated visible trade deficit of 1.4 million as compared with a deficit of \$0.1 million for the same period of 2009.

During this period Caricom imports were approximately \$3.0 million less than those over the same period in 2009, a decrease of 1.4%. Total exports to Caricom for January - October 2010 were \$4.5 million more than total exports for the corresponding period 2009, a decrease of 2.1%. Domestic exports decreased by \$0.5 million or 0.3% over the same period 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$4.0 million or 9.0% over the January - October 2009 figure.

OCTOBER 2010 WITH THE CORRESPONDING MONTH OF 2009**

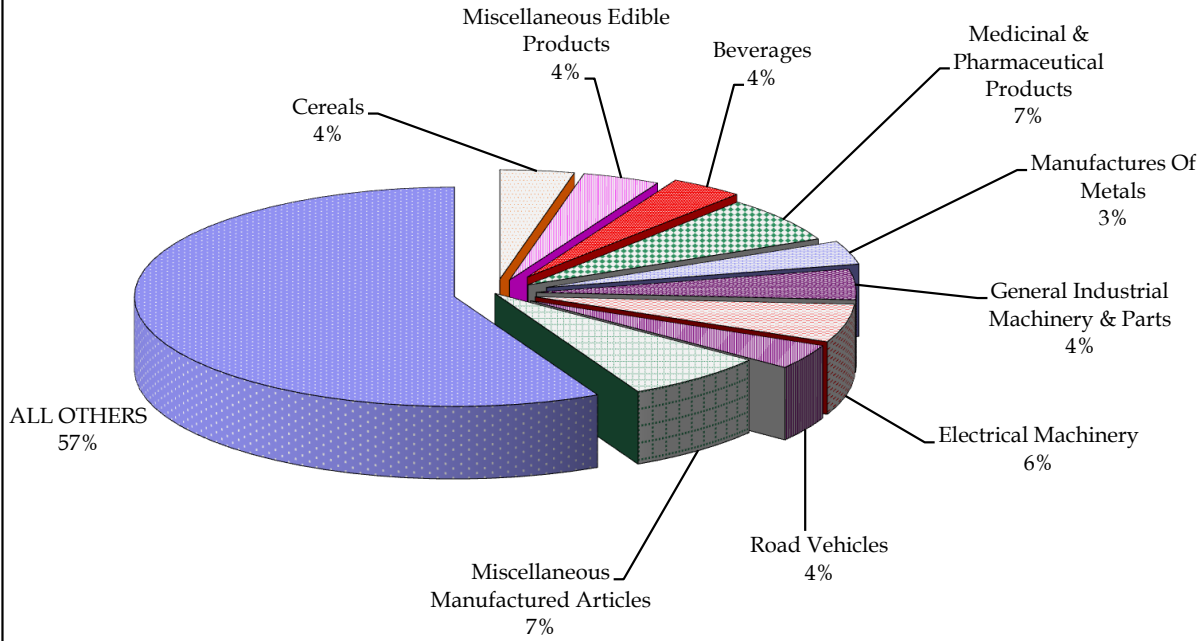

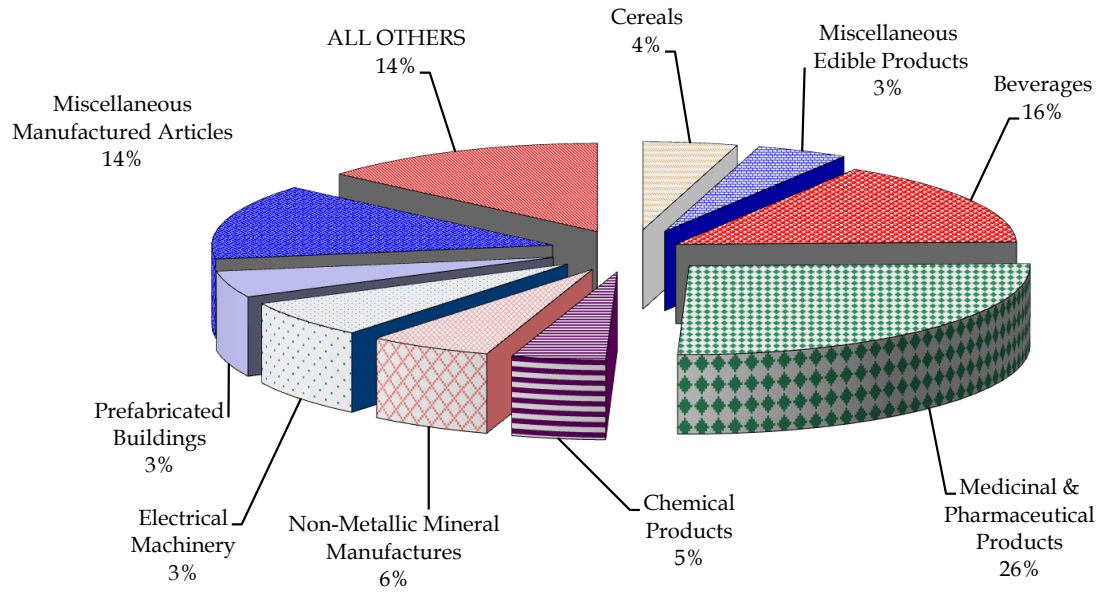

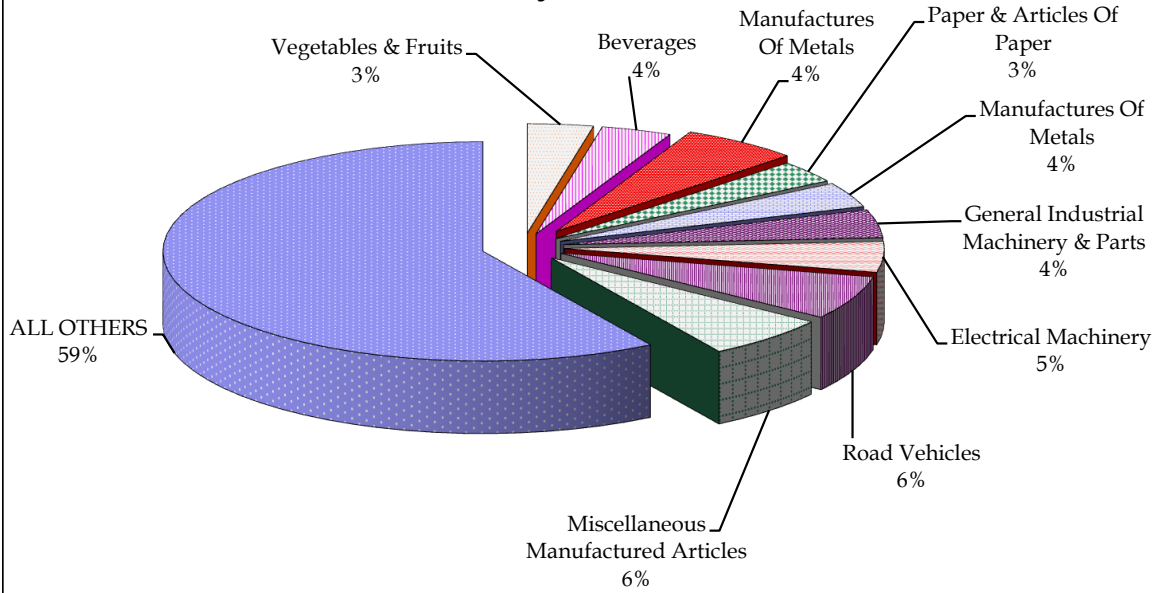

Principal Domestic Exports January- October 2010

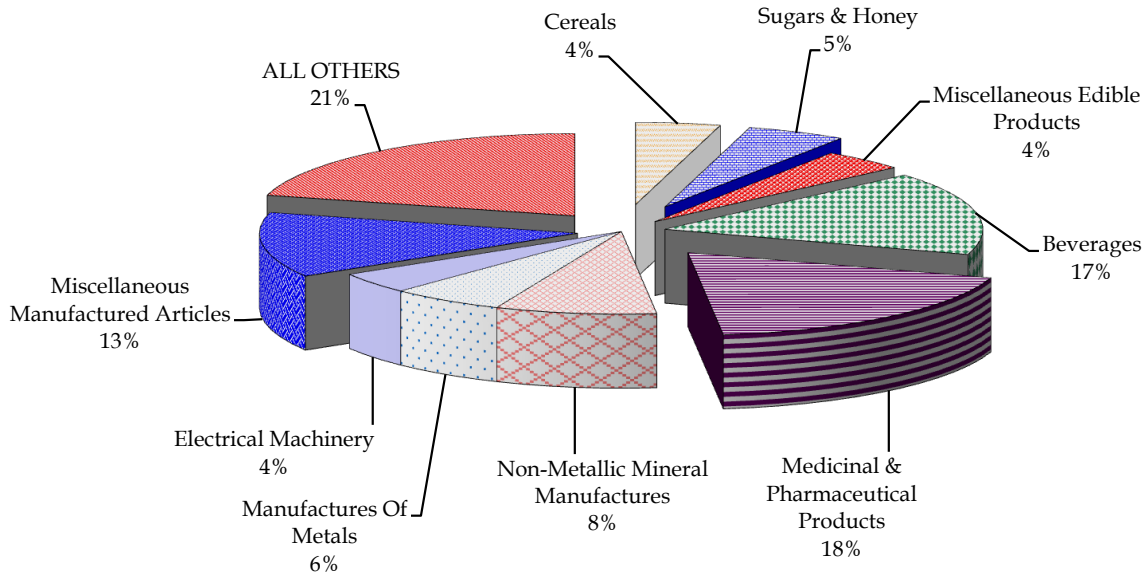

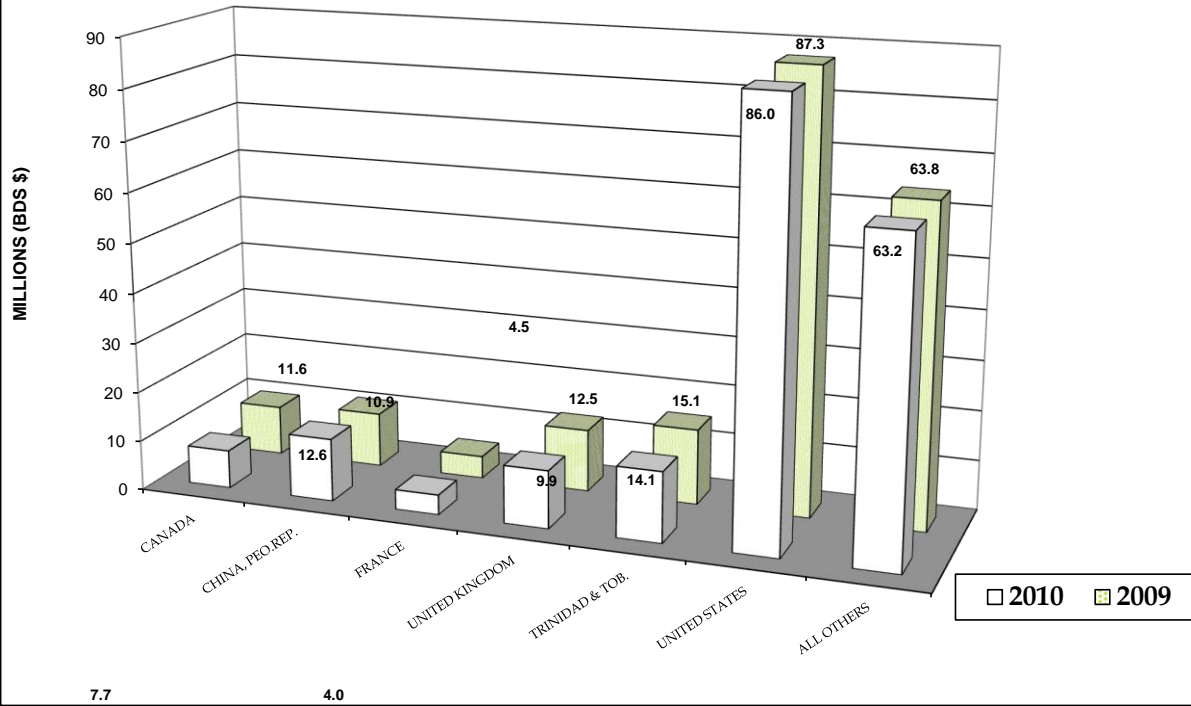

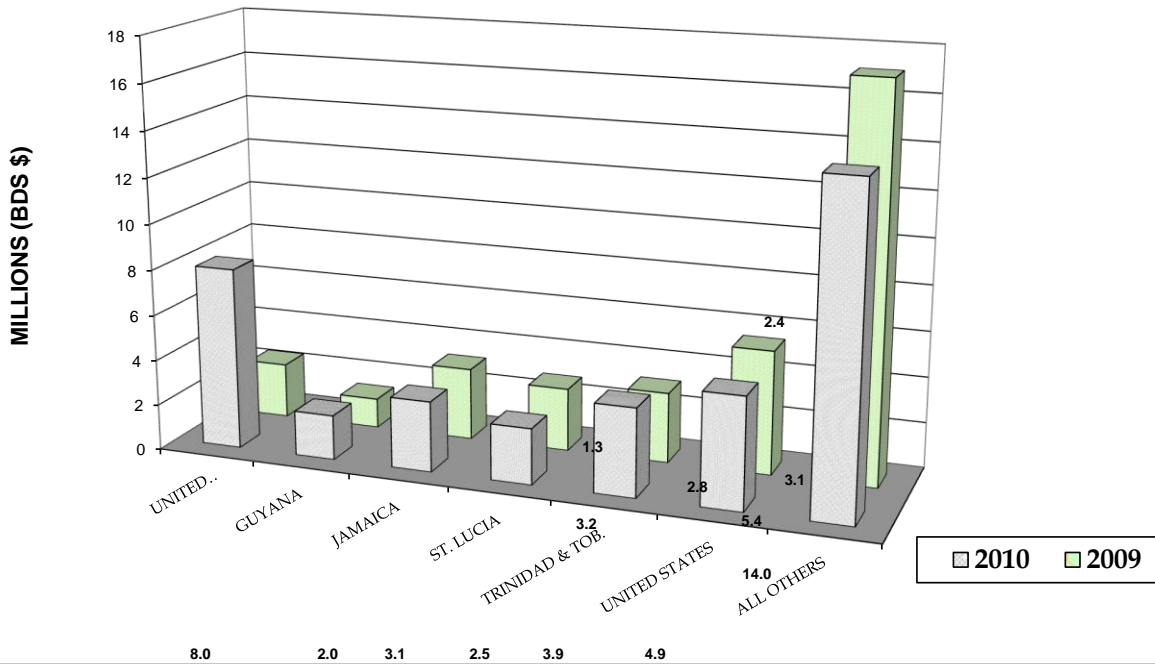

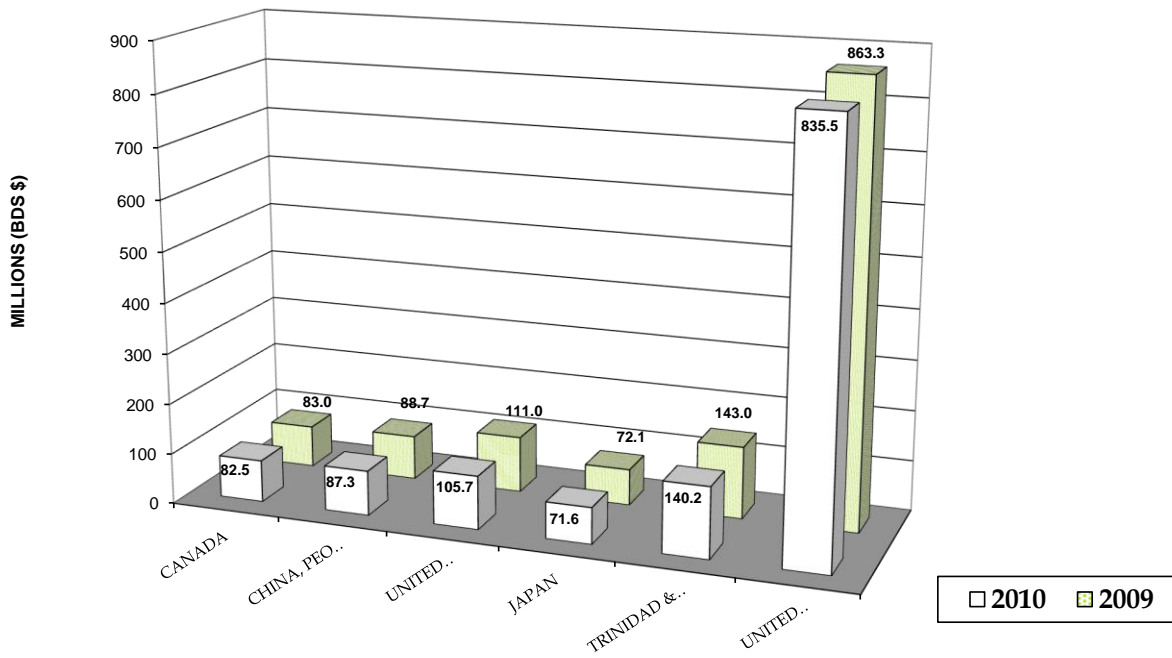

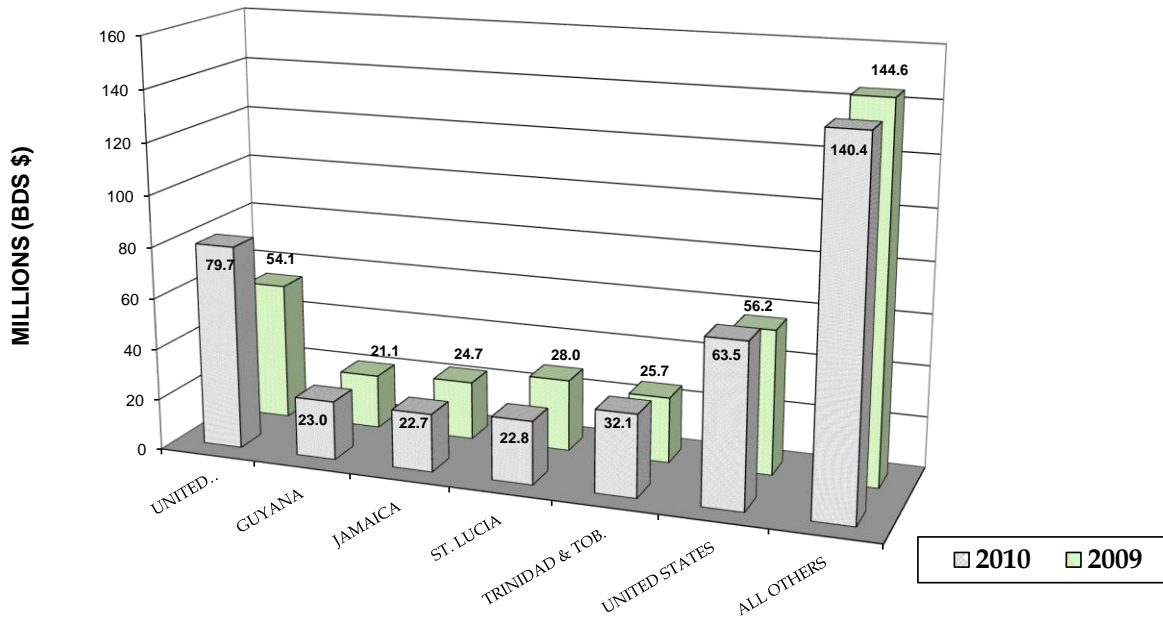

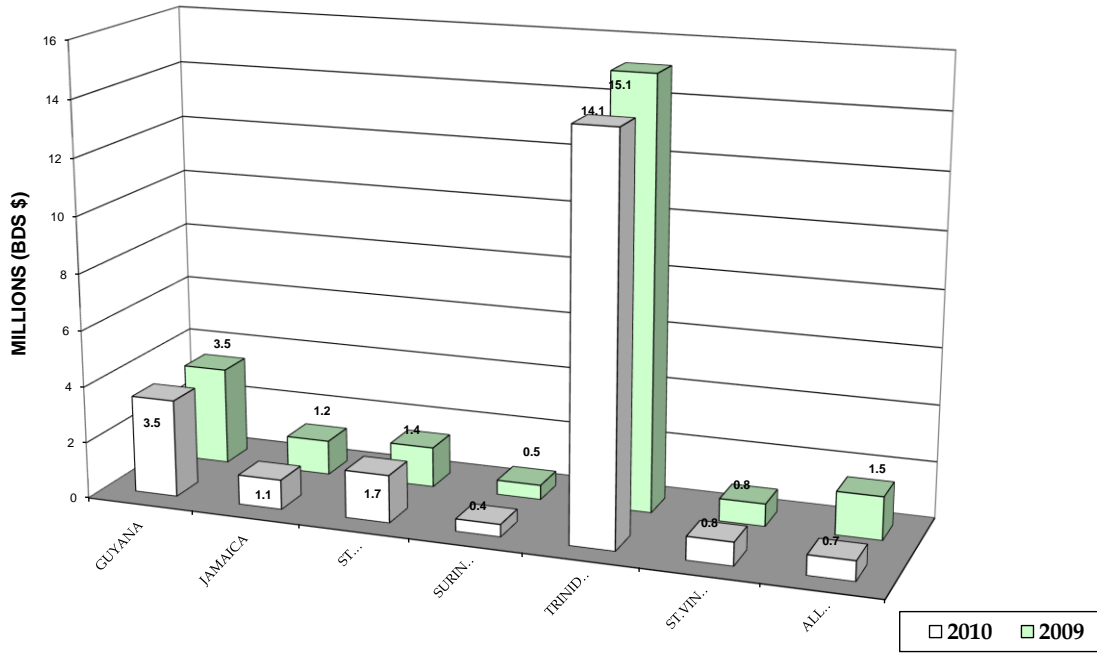

OCTOBER 2010 WITH THE CORRESPONDING MONTH OF 2009

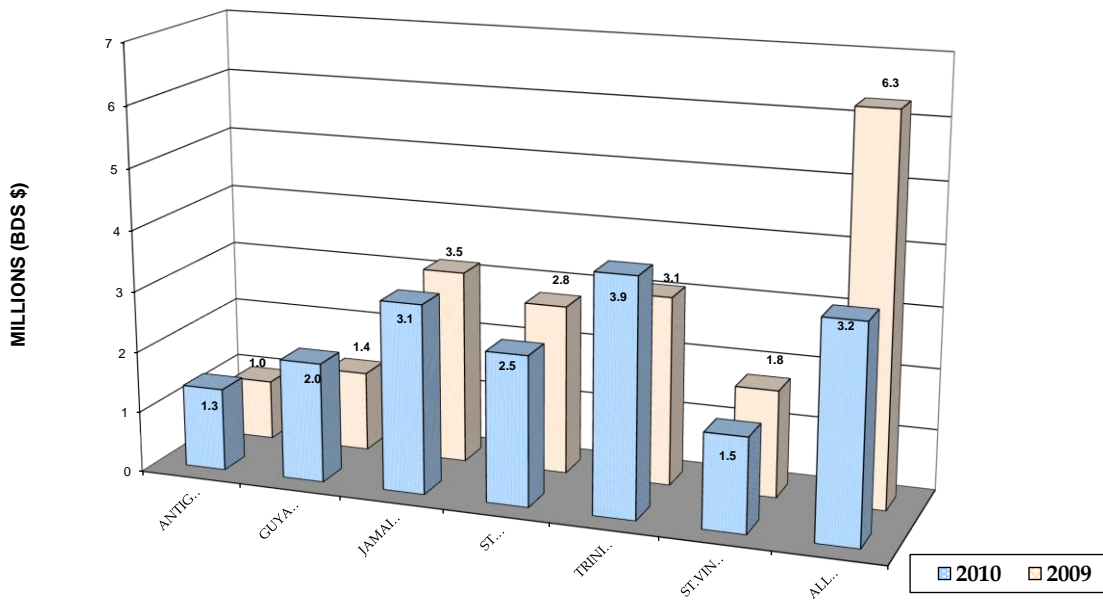

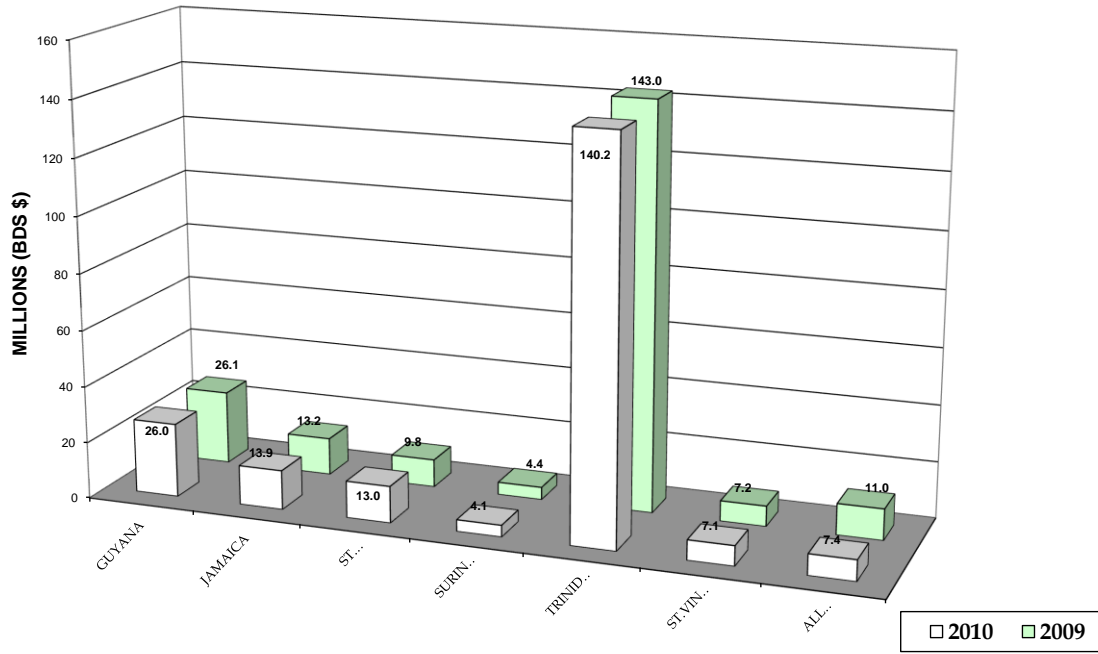

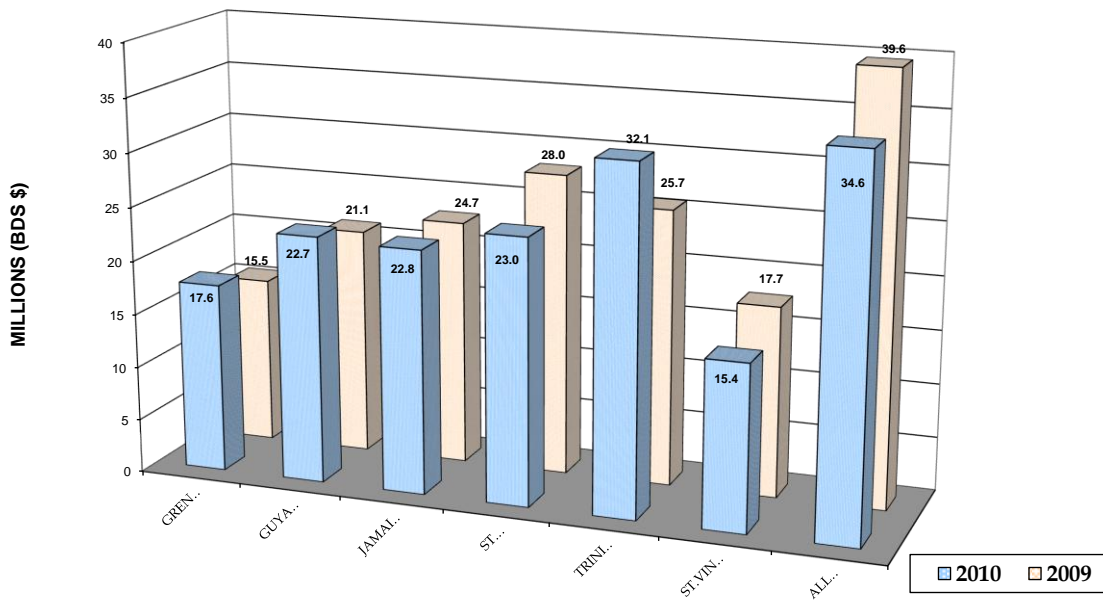
