OVERSEAS TRADE

SEPTEMBER 2010

REVIEW OF OVERSEAS TRADE

During the month of September 2010 imports to Barbados were valued at \$207.4 million, whilst total exports from Barbados were valued at \$53.4 million. This resulted in a visible trade deficit of \$154.0 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$139.4 million for September 2009.

Imports for September 2010 were \$22.2 million less than imports for September 2010, a decrease of 12.0%. Total exports decreased in value by some \$7.6 million or 16.7% of the September 2009 figure. Domestic exports decreased by \$10.2 million or 29.9% over September 2009. However, re-exports decreased by \$2.6 million or 21.8% over the corresponding month 2009.

For the period January - September 2010 the value of imports to Barbados was \$1729.0 million, whilst the value of total exports was \$466.7 million representing an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$1262.4 million as compared to a similar deficit of \$1239.6 million for January - September 2009.

Imports for January - September 2010 were \$13.0 million less than imports for the same period 2009, a decrease of 0.8%. Total exports showed an increase of some \$9.7 million or 2.0% over the January - September 2009 figure. Domestic exports decreased by \$30.3 million or 9.6% over January - September 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$40.0 million or 25.2% over the corresponding period 2009.

CARICOM TRADE

During the month of September 2010 imports from Caricom countries were valued at \$21.4 million whilst total exports to Caricom were valued at \$21.2 million resulting in a trade deficit of \$0.2 million as compared with a visible trade deficit of \$0.8 million for September 2009.

Caricom imports for September 2010 were \$0.1 million less than Caricom imports for September 2009, a decrease of 0.7%. Total exports to Caricom for September 2010 were \$0.9 million less than total exports for September 2009, a decrease of 4.0%. Domestic exports decrease by \$1.4 million or 7.1% over the corresponding month 2009. However, the value of re-exports increase by \$0.5 million or 15.6% of the September 2009 figure.

For the period January - September 2010 total imports from Caricom were valued at \$189.5 million whilst total exports were \$189.3 million resulting in an accumulated visible trade deficit of \$0.1 million as compared with a deficit of \$1.7 million for the same period of 2009.

During this period Caricom imports were approximately \$1.2 million less than those over the same period in 2009, a decrease of 0.6%. Total exports to Caricom for January - September 2010 were \$3.0 million less than total exports for the corresponding period 2009, a decrease of 1.6%. Domestic exports decrease by \$1.0 million or 0.7% over the same period 2009. However, the value of re-exports decreased by \$4.1 million or 9.9% over the January - September 2009 figure.

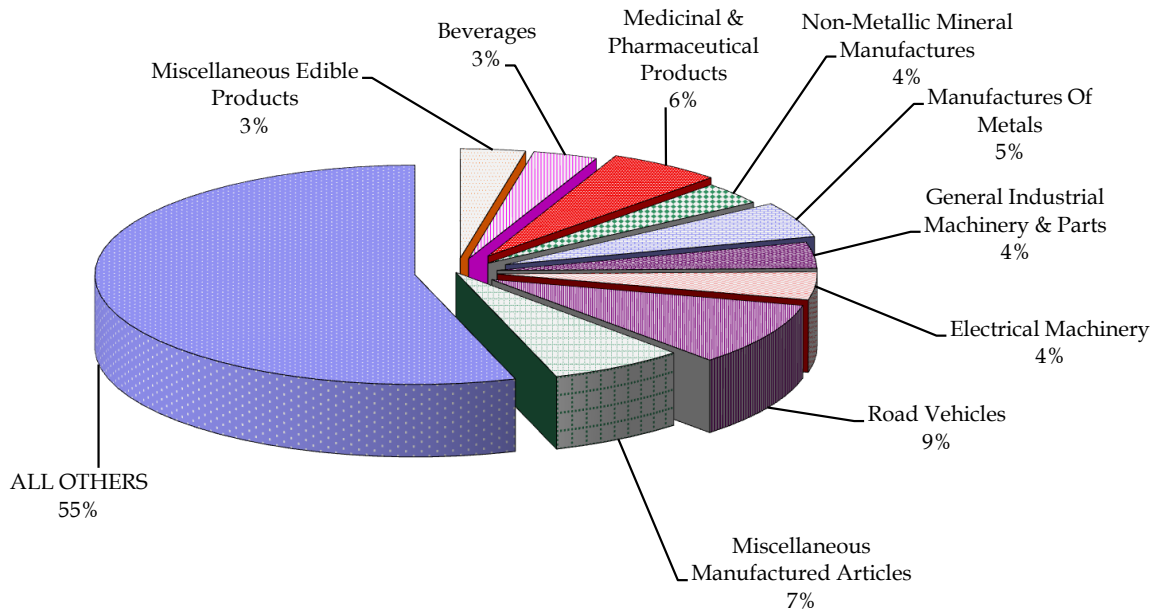

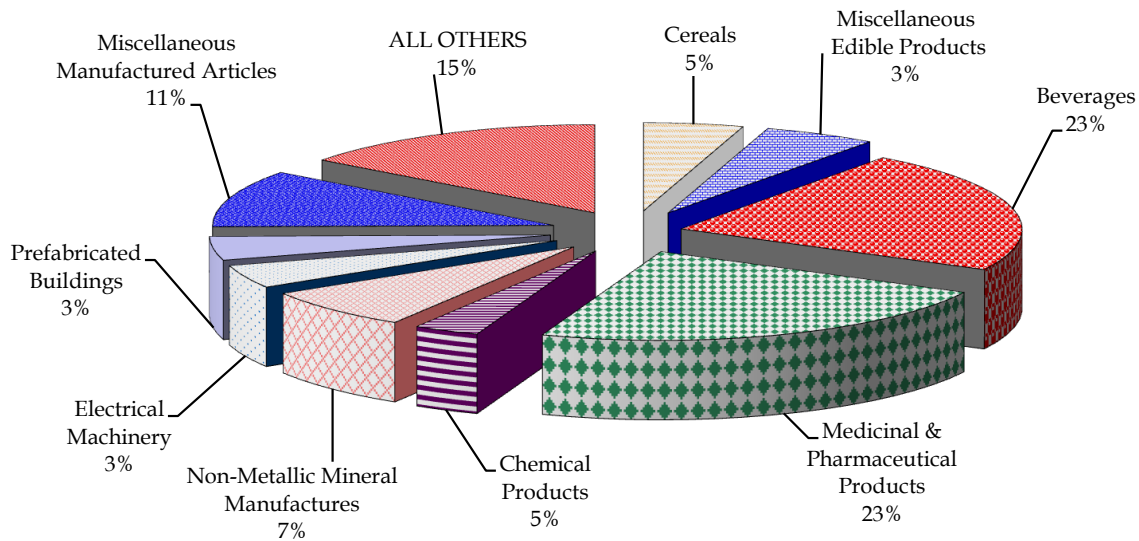

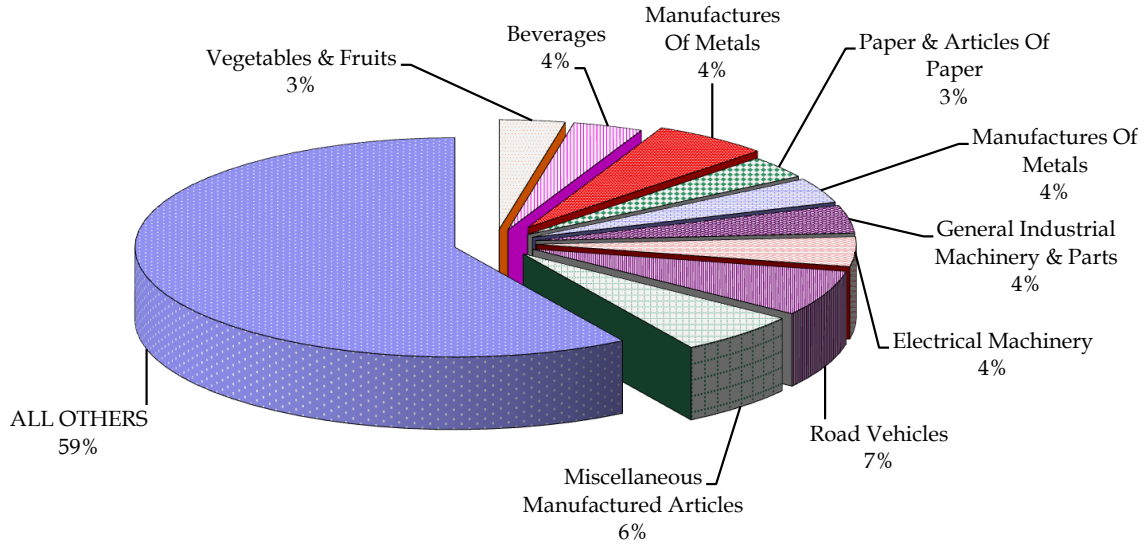

Principal Domestic Exports January- September 2010

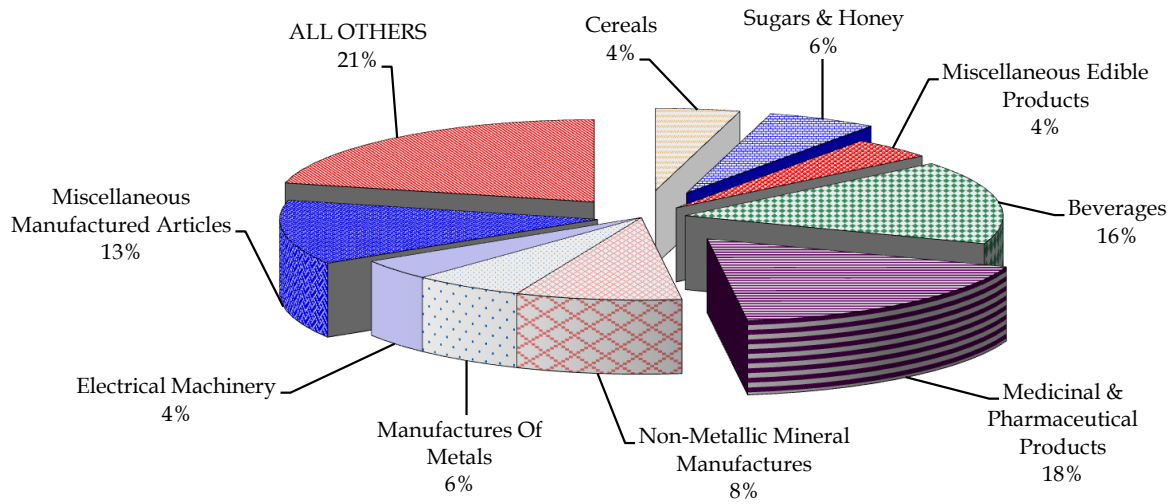

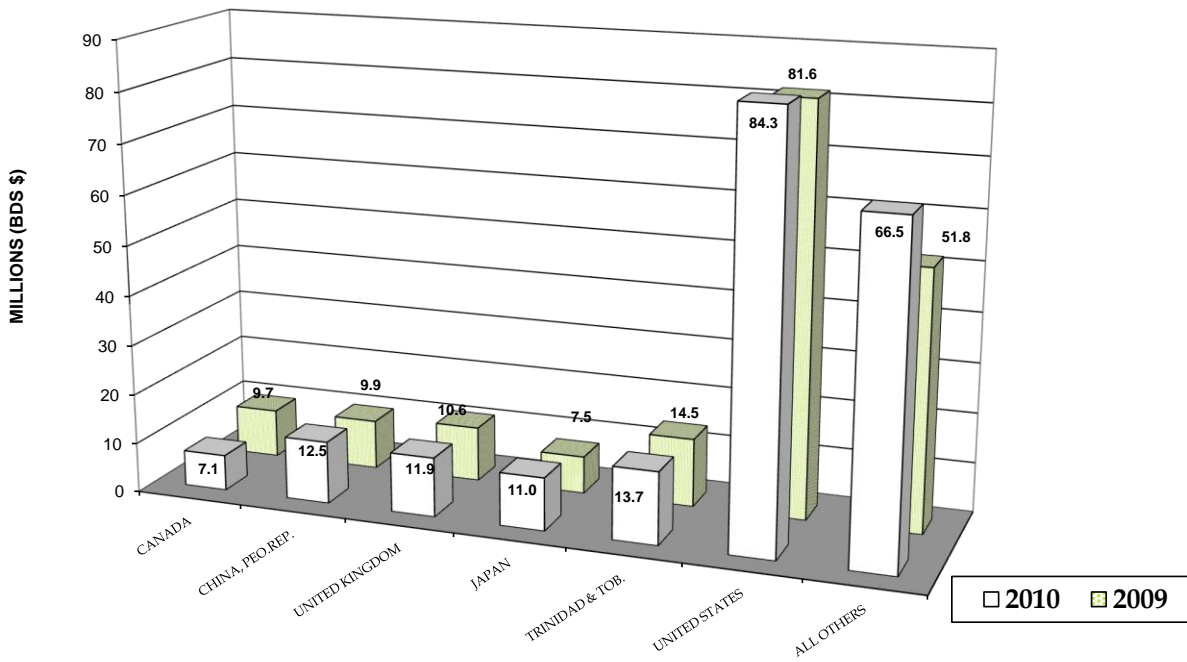

SEPTEMBER 2010 WITH THE CORRESPONDING MONTH OF 2009

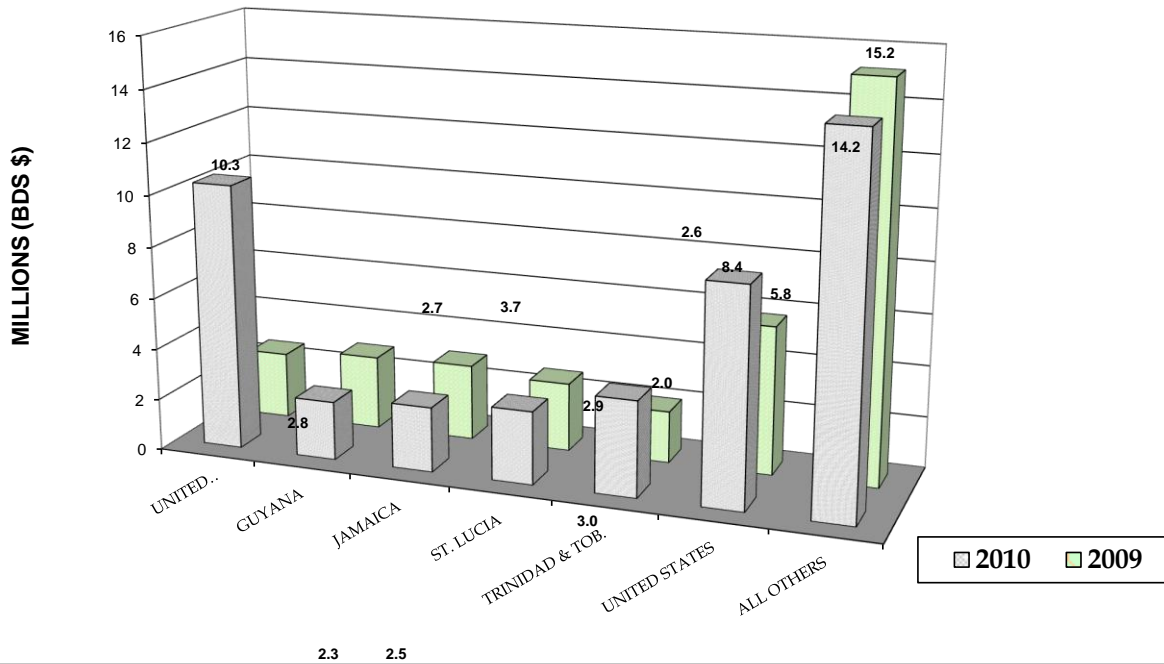

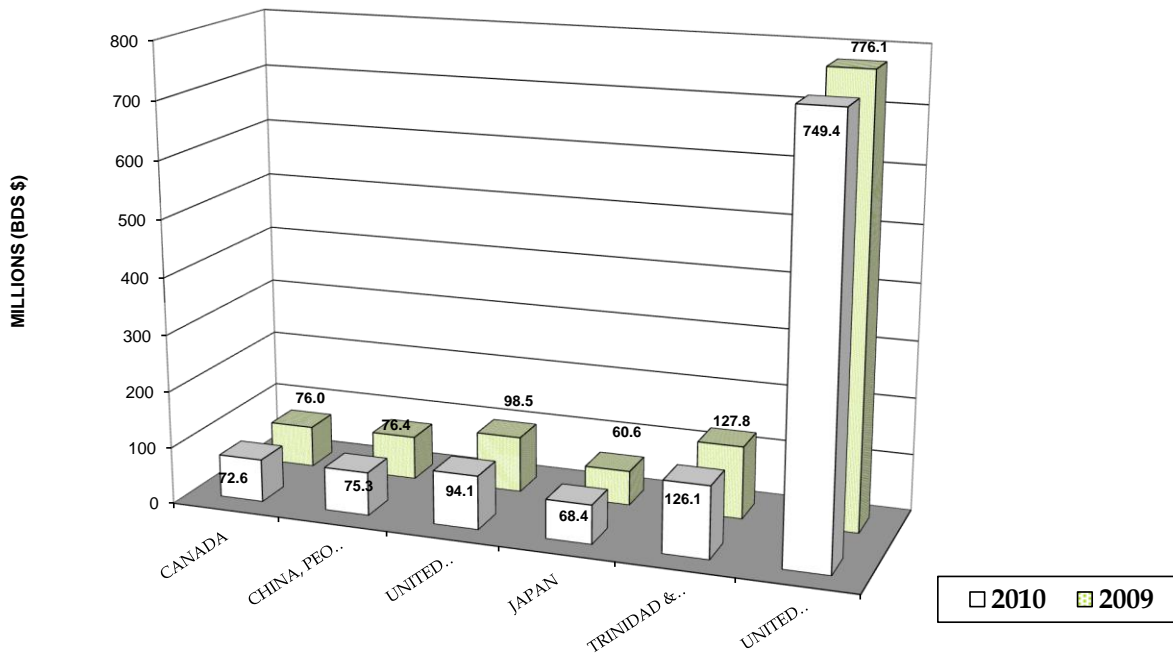

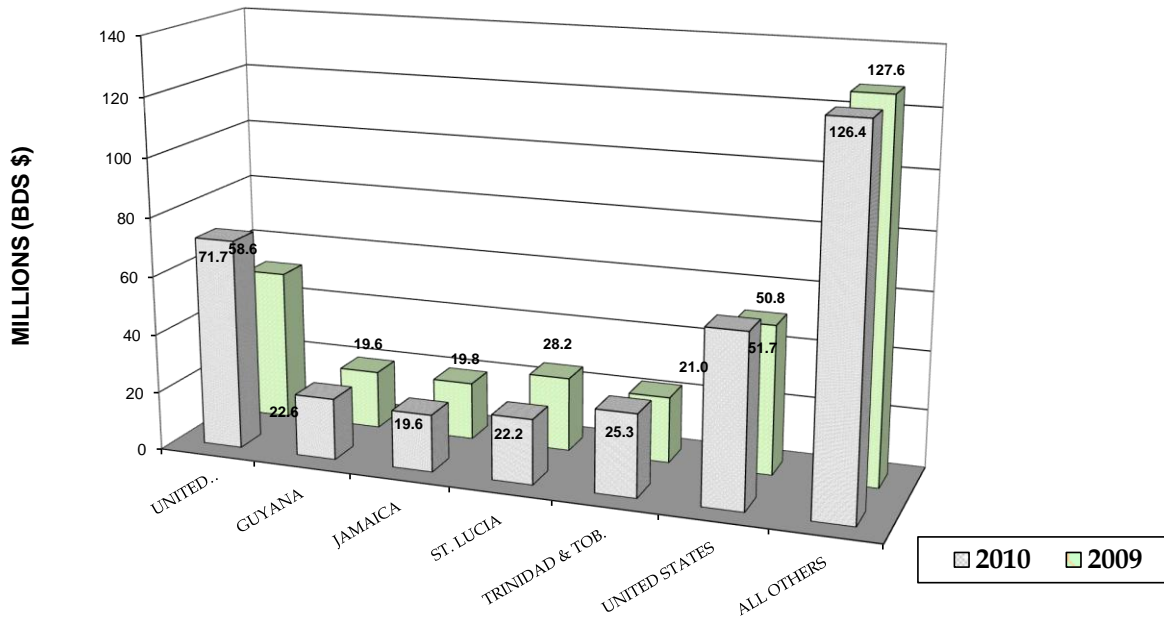

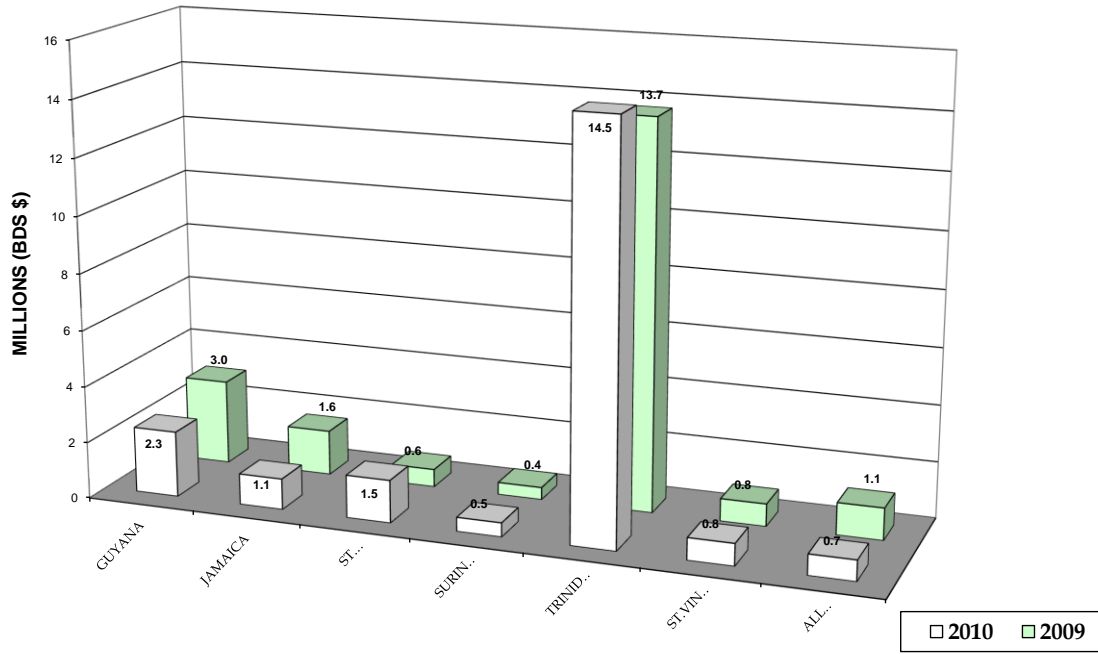

SEPTEMBER 2010 WITH THE CORRESPONDING MONTH OF 2009

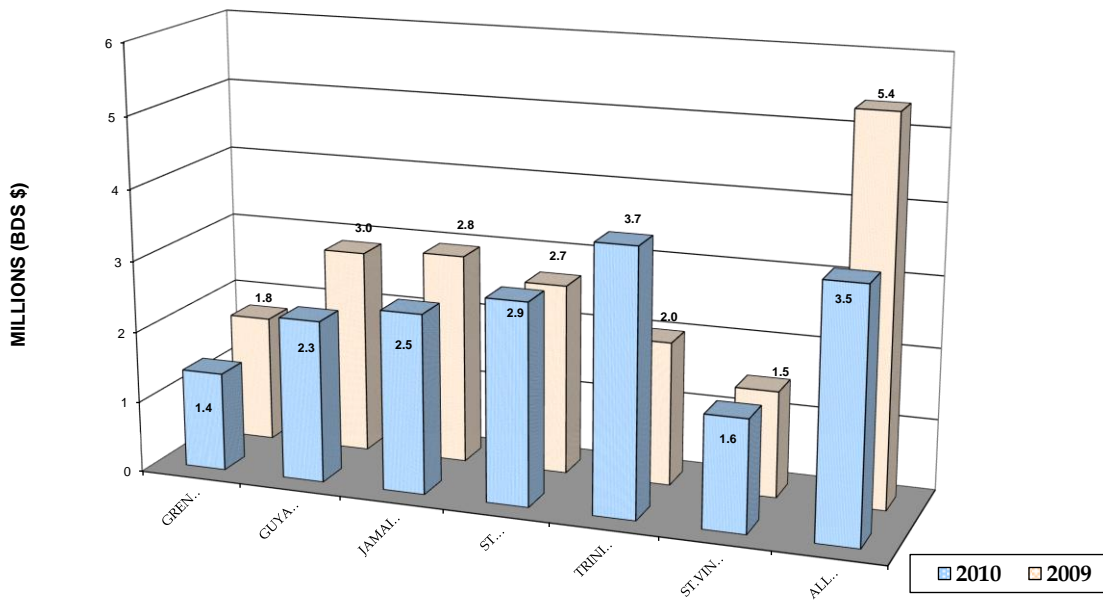

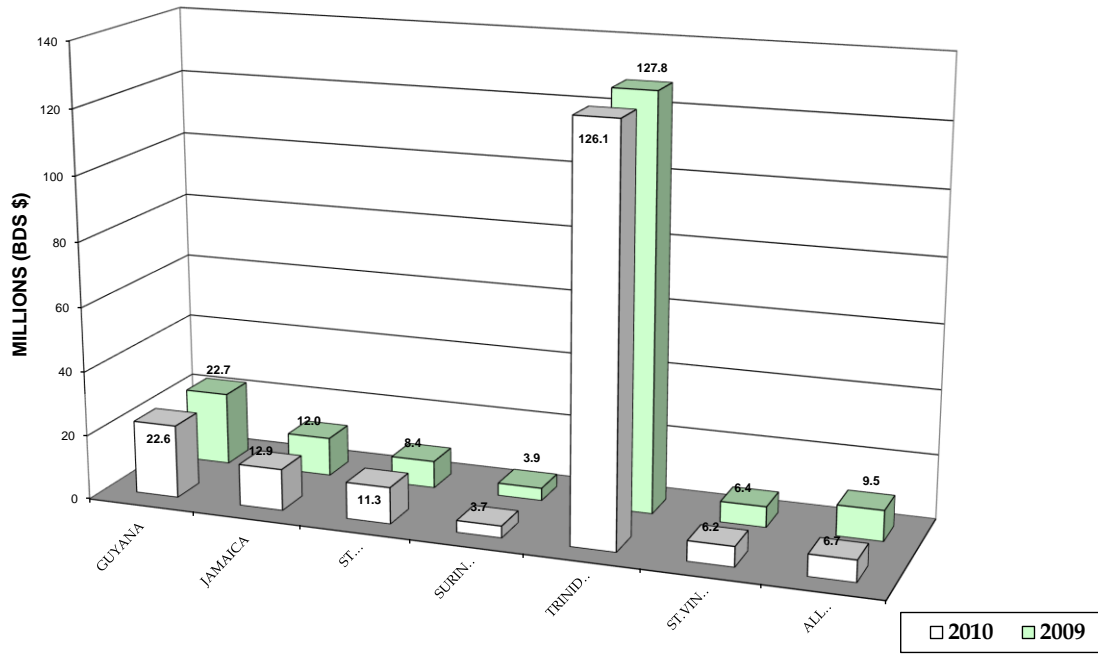

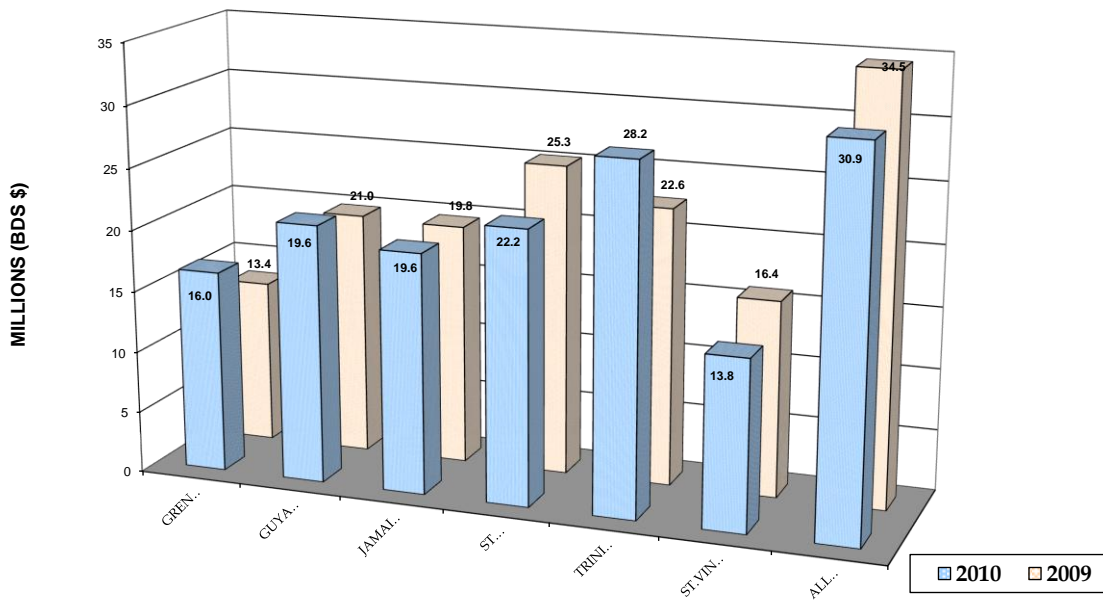
