

**COMPARISON OF TOURIST ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE**  
**FEBRUARY 2009 AND 2010**

Stay-over visitor arrivals for February 2010 numbered 48,585 representing a decrease of 1,253 or 2.5% when compared to February 2009. There were decreases in the U.K., Trinidad & Tobago and Other Caricom markets of 4,645 or 22.2 %, 1,699 or 78 % and 3,643 or 564 % respectively. While the U.S.A., Canada, Germany, Other

Europe, and Other Countries recorded increases of 2,796 or 29.9%, 772 or 8.7%, 124 or 23.3%, 231 or 9.5%, and 111 or 6.2% respectively. Cruise Passenger arrivals for February 2009 were 80,364 representing an increase of 2,261 or 2.7% when compared to February 2009.

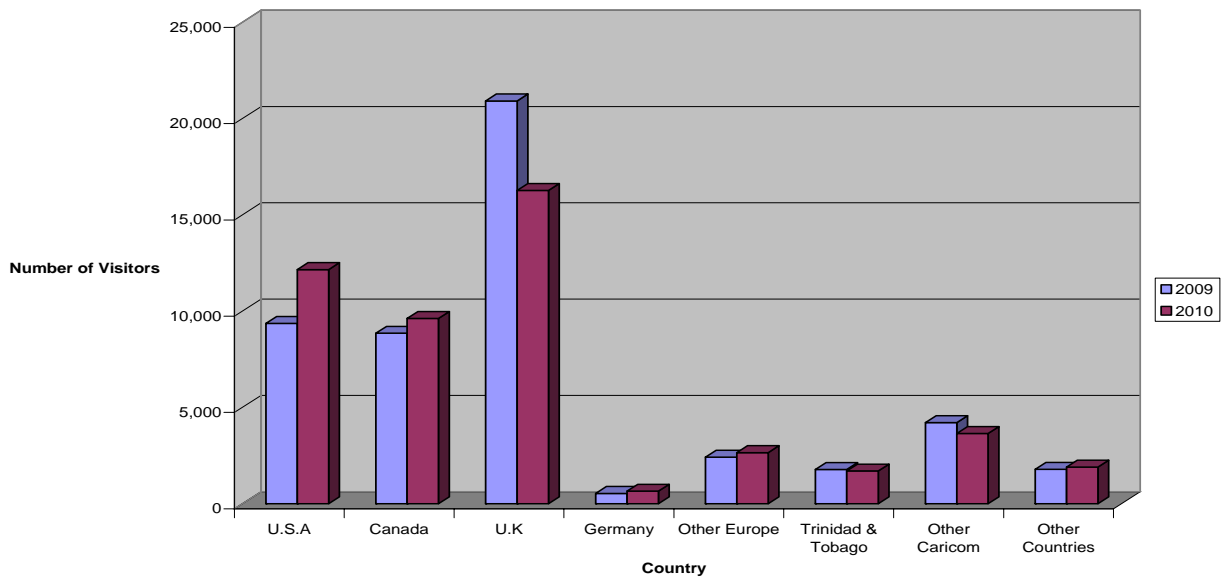

**JANUARY TO FEBRUARY 2009 AND 2010**

Stay-over visitor arrivals for the period January to February 2009 was 96,921. This represented an increase of 1,628 or 1.7%. The markets of the U.S.A., Canada, Germany, Other Europe, Trinidad & Tobago and Other Countries increased by 5,004 or 27.6%, 2,313 or 13.7%, 85 or 6.6%, 44 or 0.8%, 96 or 2.8% and 76 or 2.2%

respectively. While the markets of the U.K and Other Caricom recorded decreases of 5,446 or 14.5% and 8,329 or 544 respectively.

Cruise passenger arrivals were 164,994. This represented a decrease of 11,068 or 6.3% when compared to the corresponding period in 2009.

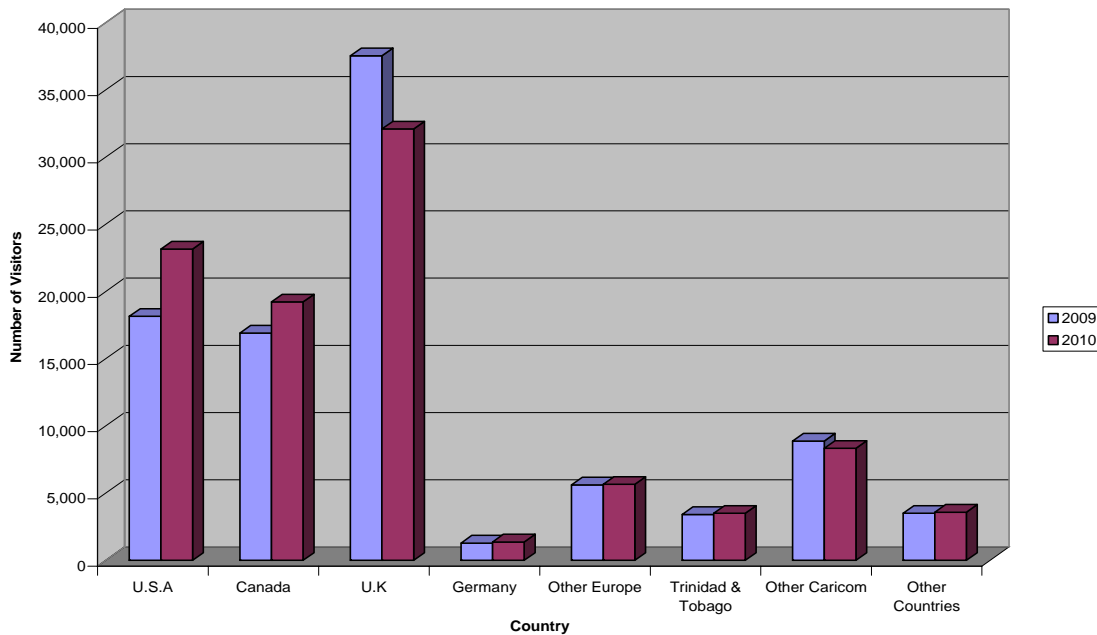
