

**COMPARISON OF TOURIST ARRIVALS BY COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE**  
**OCTOBER 2008 AND 2009**

Stay-over visitor arrivals for October 2009 numbered 38,757 representing a decrease of 1,411 or 3.5 % when compared to October 2008. There were increases in the U.S.A, Canada and Germany markets of 2,809 or 37.4 %, 7 or 0.3 % and 16 or 3.0 % respectively. Decreases of 2,914 or 16.1 %, 24 or 1.7

%, 182 or 8.7 %, 922 or 15.8 % and 201 or 9.7 % were seen in the U.K, Other Europe, Trinidad and Tobago, Other Caricom and Other Countries markets respectively. Cruise Passenger arrivals for October 2009 were 26,988 representing an increase of 12,584 or 87.4 % when compared to October 2008.

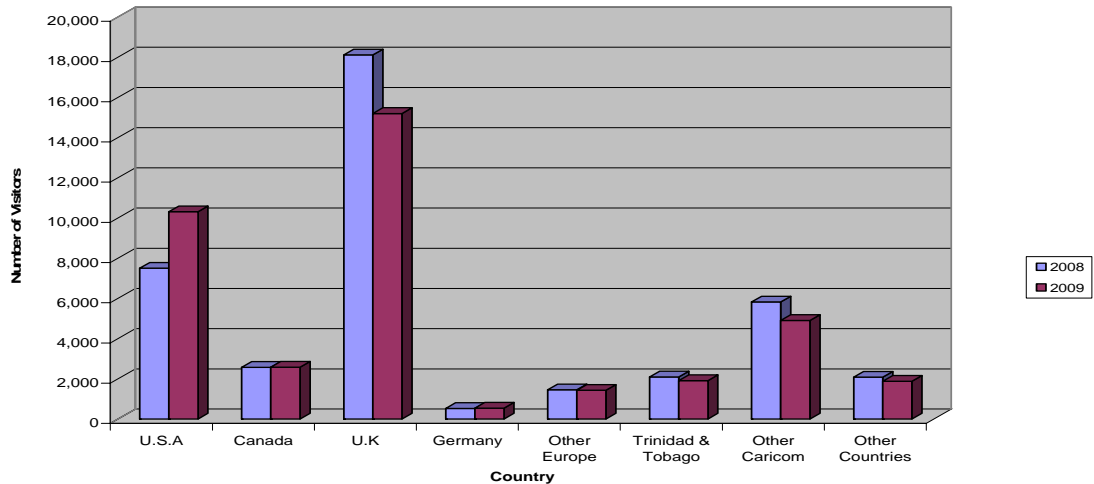

**JANUARY TO OCTOBER 2008 AND 2009**

Stay-over visitor arrivals for the period January to October 2009 numbered 418,578 which represented a decrease of 50,491 or 10.8 % when compared with the same period in 2008. Increases in the Canada and Germany markets were 4,488 or 10.4 % and 759 or 16.1 % respectively. Decreases of 15,369 or 13.9 %, 25,210 or 13.9 %, 1,935 or 9.5 %, 2,077 or 8.5 %, 8,534 or 13.8 %

and 2,613 or 12.0 % were seen in the U.S.A, U.K, Other Europe, Trinidad & Tobago, Other Caricom and Other Countries markets respectively. Cruise passenger arrivals were 469,711. This represented an increase of 24,643 or 5.5 % when compared to the corresponding period in 2008.

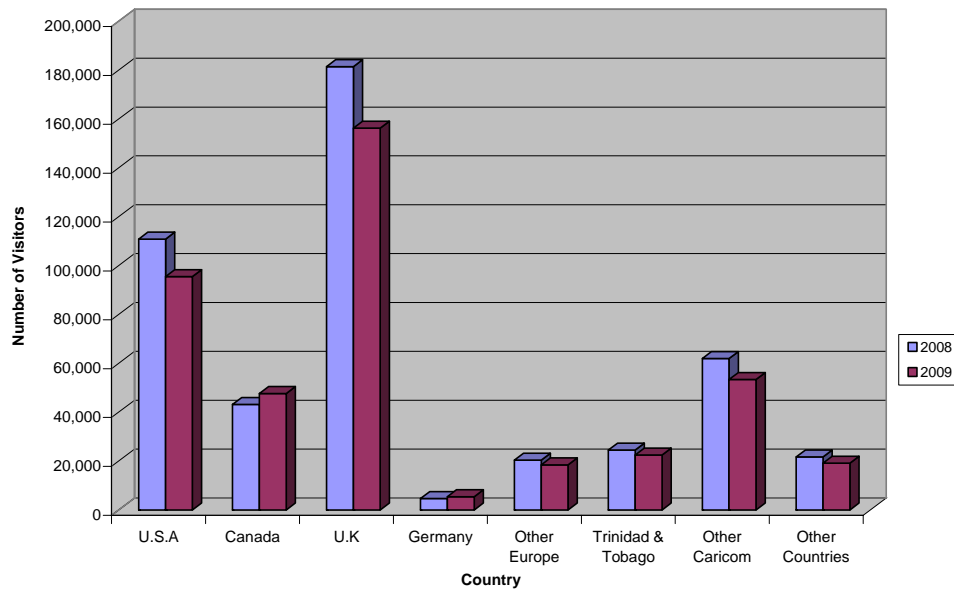
